## **EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION**

The proposed legislation requires all revenue generated from the fee increase to used by the Office of Public Health (OPH) to administer the Safe Drinking Water Program.

### **REVENUE EXPLANATION**

### Office of Public Health

The proposed legislation increases Fees and Self-Generated Revenues by \$13,461,600 in FY 17 and in future fiscal years within the Department of Health & Hospitals, Office of Public Health (OPH). The proposed legislation increases the existing administration fee of the Safe Water Drinking Program from \$3.20 (water systems retain \$0.32) to \$12 (water systems retain \$0.60). ### **Public Water Systems**

Safe Drinking Water Admin. Fee\*

The proposed legislation increases the Safe Water Drinking Program administration fee retained by water systems from \$0.32 to \$0.60. To the extent some of the 1,341 water systems are owned by local governmental units, the \$0.28 fee increase is anticipated to increase local revenues by an indeterminable amount.
