Abstract: Specifies that the motion to lay on the table shall be in order on any matter or motion in the possession of the House regardless of the house of origin.

<u>Present House Rules</u> (House Rules 9.8 and 9.9) provide that the motion to lay on the table shall be decided without debate and provide that a matter once laid on the table shall be called from the table only upon the favorable vote of two-thirds of the members present and voting. <u>Present House Rules</u> (House Rules 9.4 and 9.5) further provide that no more than one substitute motion shall be in order at any one time and that motions having a higher precedence shall be in order and motions having a lower precedence shall not be in order.

<u>Proposed House Rule</u> retains <u>present House Rules</u> and further provides that the motion to lay on the table shall be in order in accordance with <u>present House Rules</u> (Ch. 9 regarding motions) on any matter or motion in the possession of the House regardless of the house of origin.
