COMMENDATIONS. Commends Dr. David R. Heitmeier for his exemplary service to the state of Louisiana and the constituency of Senate District Seven.

A RESOLUTION

2	To commend the Honorable David R. Heitmeier, OD, former state senator representing
3	District Seven and the parishes of Orleans, Jefferson, and Plaquemines, for his
4	outstanding accomplishments and exemplary public service to the citizens of the
5	state of Louisiana.
6	WHEREAS, it is with great pride that the members of the Senate of the Legislature
7	of Louisiana recognize the Honorable David R. Heitmeier for a job well done and for his
8	singular efforts to affect positive change in government through his extraordinary legislative
9	service; and
10	WHEREAS, as a lifelong resident of Algiers, Dr. David Heitmeier has rendered a
11	remarkable record of public service, having rigorously served the communities of Gretna,
12	Terrytown, Harvey, and Belle Chasse with prestige for eight years; and
13	WHEREAS, during his tenure Dr. Heitmeier embodied the best qualities of a public
14	servant possessing honesty and integrity and taking personal responsibility to address the
15	issues of his constituency that included delivery of health care services and local
16	transportation infrastructure; and
17	WHEREAS, David Richard Heitmeier was born the youngest son of Dewey J.
18	Heitmeier, an Algiers businessman, and Barbara "Bobbie" Cargol Heitmeier, a judicial

1	employee of the Orleans Parish Civil District Court, and reared along with two older
2	brothers, Francis and Robert "Bobby" Heitmeier, in an exuberant household flavored with
3	the influences of New Orleans culture and local politics; and
4	WHEREAS, after attending Holy Cross High School in New Orleans, David obtained
5	an undergraduate degree in biological, mathematical, and physical sciences from the
6	University of Southwestern Louisiana, now known as the University of Louisiana at
7	Lafayette; and he later graduated with a doctorate in Optometry from the University of
8	Houston in 1987; and
9	WHEREAS, choosing to return to the community that he loved, David founded the
10	optometric practice of Heitmeier & Armani Medical & Surgical Eyecare; his hard work and
11	innovation earned him the admiration of his colleagues; and his acumen in patient care and
12	medical ethics led to speaking engagements at regional and national conferences; and
13	WHEREAS, in 2007, with a genuine interest in the needs of the people and with the
14	encouragement of family and friends, David Heitmeier ran a successful campaign and
15	succeeded in capturing the Senate seat previously held by his brother, the Honorable Francis
16	C. Heitmeier, and was successfully reelected in 2011, without opposition; and
17	WHEREAS, during his two terms, David garnered committee assignments to Senate
18	Judiciary B as vice chairman, Transportation, Highways and Public Works, Environmental
19	Quality, and Revenue and Fiscal Affairs; and
20	WHEREAS, it was as chairman of the Senate Health and Welfare Committee that
21	Senator Heitmeier focused on health planning, preventative public health measures, smoking
22	cessation, nutrition, and obesity studies; and instituted policy changes like the Upper
23	Payment Limit program that increased federal matching funds earmarked for hospitals and
24	health care providers to offset the costs for uncompensated care; and
25	WHEREAS, Senator Heitmeier penned legislation to address local issues of funding
26	for transportation improvements in drainage, infrastructure, traffic flow, bridges and tunnel
27	repairs; and
28	WHEREAS, after hurricanes Gustav and Ike, Senator Heitmeier worked with parish
29	governments to assure eyecare assistance for storm victims; and

WHEREAS, many professional, civic, and nonprofit agencies have benefitted from

1	his active participation which include the American Optometric Association, the Louisiana
2	Optometric Association, the Algiers Economic Development Foundation, the Plaquemines
3	Association of Business and Industry, the Ochsner West Bank Health Systems, Special
4	Olympics, and Goodwill Industries of Southeastern Louisiana, Inc.; and
5	WHEREAS, David Heitmeier has been the recipient of numerous accolades in
6	association with his professional and legislative accomplishments, far too numerous to
7	count, however his recognition as the 2015 Optometrist of the Year by the American
8	Optometric Association, the Inspired Cross Award by the Daughters of Charity Services of
9	New Orleans, and the Extra Mile of Southeast Louisiana, Inc. 2015 Health Care Champion
10	Award, have brought particular satisfaction; and
11	WHEREAS, although the demands of public life keep him quite busy, be assured that
12	family is always his first concern; elder daughter, Leah Elizabeth, has followed in her
13	father's footsteps to obtain a doctor of Optometry degree from his alma mater, the University
14	of Houston, and younger daughter, Meghan Rose, has obtained an undergraduate degree in
15	education from Southeastern Louisiana University; and the successes of his children fill his
16	heart with pride; and
17	WHEREAS, as David Heitmeier returns to the private sector, he deserves heartfelt
18	thanks for those extraordinary strides confected to improve health care delivery while
19	serving as an exceptional member of the Louisiana Legislature.
20	THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Senate of the Legislature of Louisiana
21	does hereby commend former senator, David R. Heitmeier, OD for his years of dedicated
22	public service to this body and the state of Louisiana.
