MEDICAID. Provides for the Louisiana Health Insurance Premium Payment Program. (gov sig)

1	AN ACT
2	To enact Part VIII of Chapter 3 of Title 46 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950, to be
3	comprised of R.S. 46:451 through 455, relative to the Louisiana Medical Assistance
4	Program; to provide for the Health Insurance Premium Assistance Program; to
5	provide for rules and regulations; and to provide for related matters.
6	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
7	Section 1. Part VIII of Chapter 3 of Title 46 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of
8	1950, comprised of R.S. 46:451 through 455, is hereby enacted to read as follows:
9	PART VIII. LOUISIANA HEALTH INSURANCE
10	PREMIUM PAYMENT PROGRAM
11	<u>§451. Legislative intent</u>
12	The Legislature of Louisiana finds that it is in the best interest of the
13	state of Louisiana to operate a premium assistance program in the Medicaid
14	program that would require Medicaid recipients to enroll or maintain
15	enrollment in their employer-sponsored insurance plan when doing so would be
16	cost effective to the state of Louisiana and ensure that Medicaid functions as the
17	payer of last resort.

1	§452. Health insurance premium payment program; creation
2	A. There is hereby created the Louisiana Health Insurance Premium
3	Payment Program. The program shall be implemented and administered by the
4	Department of Health and Hospitals in accordance with federal law and
5	regulations.
6	B. The program shall be within the Medicaid program and shall be made
7	available to any Medicaid recipient when it is determined that it would be cost
8	beneficial to the state to cover the expenses of allowing an individual who is
9	Medicaid eligible to enroll or remain enrolled in any available employer-
10	sponsored health insurance plan when compared to the costs the state would
11	incur if the Medicaid program were to provide primary coverage directly
12	through the Medicaid program.
13	§453. HIPP recipients; Medicaid managed care
14	A. The department shall conduct a survey of all existing Medicaid
15	enrollees to identify the current Medicaid enrollees that have an opportunity to
16	access employer-sponsored insurance coverage either directly or through a
17	family member. The department shall further develop and execute a plan to
18	<u>transition those Medicaid enrollees identified in the survey to</u>
19	employer-sponsored coverage as soon as it is appropriate.
20	B. The department shall exclude from participation in a managed care
21	organization any Medicaid recipient who is enrolled in the Health Insurance
22	<u>Premium Payment Program.</u>
23	§454. Rules and regulations
24	The secretary of the department shall promulgate all rules and
25	regulations, in accordance with the provisions of the Administrative Procedure
26	Act, that may be necessary and proper to implement the provisions of this Part.
27	§455. Reporting
28	The department shall submit a report annually, no later than January
29	fifteenth each year, to the House and Senate committees on health and welfare

1	that includes the following:
2	(1) The total number of Medicaid enrollees included in the Health
3	Insurance Premium Payment Program and the total number of cost-benefit
4	evaluations performed by the department.
5	(2) The total amount of premium paid on behalf of the Medicaid
6	enrollees in the program and the total savings to the state.
7	(3) A description of the algorithm used by the department to determine
8	the cost benefit to the state of enrolling Medicaid recipients into the Louisiana
9	Health Insurance Premium Payment Program.
10	Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
11	signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
12	by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
13	vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
14	effective on the day following such approval.

<u>Proposed law</u> establishes the Louisiana Health Insurance Premium Payment Program within the Medicaid program to assist with employer sponsored insurance coverage. <u>Proposed law</u> excludes this population from Bayou Health.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides rule making authority for DHH and provides for an annual report by January 15 each year which includes (1) the total number of enrollees, (2) total premiums paid, and (3) description of algorithm to determine cost benefit of utilizing this program.

Effective upon signature of the governor or upon lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
