2	To amend and reenact R.S. 11:1821(B), relative to the board of trustees of the Municipal
3	Employees' Retirement System; to grant certain trustees and their designees the
4	authority to vote; and to provide for related matters.
5	Notice of intention to introduce this Act has been published
6	as provided by Article X, Section 29(C) of the Constitution
7	of Louisiana.
8	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
9	Section 1. R.S. 11:1821(B) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
10	§1821. Board of trustees; membership; term of office; oath of office; compensation;
11	voting power; vacancies
12	* * *
13	B. The board shall be composed of eleven trustees as follows:
14	(1) Three active and contributing members of the system each of whom is
15	an elected official elected to office in accordance with the Louisiana Election Code
16	and has at least ten years of creditable service.
17	(2) Three active and contributing members of the system who are not elected
18	officials elected to office in accordance with the Louisiana Election Code, each of
19	whom has at least ten years of creditable service.
20	(3) The president of the Louisiana Municipal Association, who shall serve
21	as an ex officio member during his tenure, or his designee.

1	(4) The chairman of the Senate Committee on Retirement, who shall serve
2	as a voting an ex officio member, or his designee.
3	(5) The chairman of the House Committee on Retirement, who shall serve
4	as a voting an ex officio member, or his designee.
5	(6) The commissioner of administration, who shall be a nonvoting serve as
6	an ex officio member, or his designee.
7	(7) The state treasurer, who shall be a nonvoting serve as an ex officio
8	member, or his designee.
9	* * *
10	Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
11	signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
12	by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
13	vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
14	effective on the day following such approval.
