(KEYWORD, SUMMARY, AND DIGEST as amended by Senate committee amendments)

PARKS/STATE: Authorizes the operation of golf carts on roadways within Lake Fausse Point State Park

DIGEST

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that golf carts may operate between sunrise and sunset on the roadways within the limits of Lake Fausse Pointe State Park by any operator who is in possession of a valid driver's license and liability insurance. Defines "golf cart" as a vehicle that was originally intended for use off-road on golf courses and other green spaces and that has a maximum speed of 25 miles per hour.

<u>Proposed law</u> excepts the provisions of <u>proposed law</u> from certain requirements regarding operation of vehicles on roadways contained in <u>present law</u>.
