A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

To designate May 11, 2016, as "Louisiana Housing Council Day" at the Louisiana Legislature and commend the organization for its accomplishments.

WHEREAS, the council constantly strives to provide decent, safe, and sanitary housing and to reduce crime, poor health, and blighted property, thereby benefitting society as a whole; and WHEREAS, the Louisiana Housing Council will hold its annual Legislative Conference in Baton Rouge, Louisiana, May 10-13, 2016.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby designate May 11, 2016, as "Louisiana Housing Council Day" at the Louisiana Legislature.
