3. **HB241** **WILLMOTT** **MEDICATION ATTENDANTS** Expands the applicability of the medication attendant provisions to the office of aging and adult services
4. **HB298** **CHANEY** **LEGISLATIVE POWERS** Provides relative to the membership of the La. Commission on Civic Education
5. **HB355** **LEBAS** **CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES** Provides relative to access to state prescription monitoring program information
6. **HB390** **LEBAS** **PHARMACISTS** Clarifies definition relative to colleges of pharmacy

3. **HB273** **LORUSSO** **BOARDS/COMMISSIONS** Provides relative to reports, records, and adjudicatory functions of the La. State Board of Medical Examiners
4. **HB375** **HOFFMANN** **EXCEP PERSON/DISABLED** Provides for the EarlySteps childhood disability intervention program and authorizes a fee schedule known as cost participation for services of the program
