HOUSE BILLS ON FINAL PASSAGE-L&C - [3 items]

1. **HB326** **BARRAS** **TAX/HOTEL OCCUPANCY** Authorizes the city of Youngsville to levy a hotel occupancy tax
2. **HB44** **HAZEL** **PUBLIC RECORDS** Provides an exception to confidentiality provisions of public records law for requests made by specified entities for certain information in personnel records of certain public employees
3. **HB253** **LEOPOLD** **ELECTIONS/POLLING PLACES** Provides relative to law enforcement officers at polling places

HOUSE BILLS ON FINAL PASSAGE-R - [17 items]

1. **HB95** **DIXON** **STUDENT/SCH ATTENDANCE** Provides relative to eligibility criteria for admission or readmission to a public school and prohibits the denial of admission or readmission based on certain student characteristics
2. **HB98** **J.THOMPSON** **WEAPONS/HANDGUNS** Provides with respect to concealed handgun permits issued by sheriffs
3. **HB111** **HOFFMANN** **HEALTH/SMOKING** Prohibits outdoor smoking within 25 feet of certain exterior locations of state buildings
4. **HB173** **HAZEL** **CHILDREN** Amends Louisiana's safe haven law to provide that a child 60 days old or younger may be relinquished to a designated emergency care facility
5. **HB194** **LEGER** **STUDENT/TUITION** Provides relative to the authority of public postsecondary education management boards to increase tuition and mandatory fee amounts
6. **HB209** **GAROFALO** **LEGISLATIVE AGENCIES** Provides authority for legislative fiscal staff to access certain information from state agencies
7. **HB281** **SIMON** **HEALTH/DHH** Creates a single license for behavioral health services providers
8. **HB308** **ADAMS** **PUBLIC MEETINGS** Provides relative to public meetings of parish and municipal governing authorities
9. **HB322** **THIERRY** **CHILDREN/NEWBORNS** Requires birthing facilities to perform pulse oximetric screening for certain heart defects on each newborn in the care of those facilities
10. **HB337** **LORUSSO** **HEALTH/DHH** Provides for retail food establishment permit fees
