- SB 45 DORSEY-COLOMB POSTSECONDARY ED
Merges certain La. Technical College campuses with Baton Rouge Community College. (gov sig)
- SB 59 BUFFINGTON POSTSECONDARY ED
Requires the boards of supervisors for the Louisiana State University, Southern University, University of Louisiana and Louisiana Community and Technical College systems to broadcast the live audio and video of all board and committee meetings conducted in Baton Rouge on the Internet. (1/1/14)
- SB 77 CROWE PORTS/HARBORS/TERMINALS
Expands the jurisdiction of the Louisiana International Deep Water Gulf Transfer Terminal Authority.
(8/1/13)
- SB 98 NEVERS MOTOR VEHICLES
Requires that over-the-counter applications for motor vehicle certificates of title be made only to a public license tag agent. (1/1/14)

- SB 103 WHITE MOTOR VEHICLES
Provides for issuance of an economic and medical hardship driver's license in certain situations. (8/1/13)
- SB 117 APPEL POSTSECONDARY ED
Provides for the creation of the Outcomes-Based Funding Task Force. (gov sig)
- SB 118 APPEL POSTSECONDARY ED
Provides relative to the use, expenditure, or allocation of funds appropriated to public postsecondary education management boards. (gov sig)
- SB 147 ERDEY TRAFFIC
Prohibits any device from being used to access, read, or post to a social networking site while operating a motor vehicle. (8/1/13)
- SB 151 GUILLORY, E ROADS/HIGHWAYS
Designates portion of LA 741 in St. Landry Parish as the "Hadley J. Castille-Pecanaire Highway". (8/1/13)
- SB 202 NEVERS TOPS
Revises core curriculum requirements and the method of calculating the grade point average for TOPS awards. (gov sig)
- SB 204 ADLEY BONDS
Provides relative to the issuance of bonds to finance capital improvements for the Louisiana Community and Technical Colleges System. (2/3-CA7s6(F)(1))(gov sig)
- SB 217 SMITH, GARY ROADS/HIGHWAYS
Prohibits the transport of hazardous materials on that portion of La. Hwy. 48 designated as Apple Street in Norco. (8/1/13)
- SB 218 MORRELL ROADS/HIGHWAYS
Prohibits DOTD from collecting fines from persons not paying tolls on the Crescent City Connection. (gov sig)
- SB 229 BROOME FUNDS/FUNDING
Provides that the Louisiana Education Quality Trust Fund shall be known as the "Kevin P. Reilly, Sr. Louisiana Education Quality Trust Fund." (gov sig)
