- SB 570 LONG MINERALS  
Provides relative to the prescription of nonuse for properties transferred in connection to an economic development project. (8/1/14)
- SB 571 WALSWORTH PUBLIC DEFENDER  
Requires the Louisiana Bureau of Criminal Identification and Information to make certain records available to public defenders. (8/1/14)
- SB 572 MURRAY SPECIAL DISTRICTS  
Provides relative to the Lakeview Crime Prevention District. (gov sig)
- SB 573 CHABERT PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION  
Creates the office of multimodal commerce in the Department of Economic Development and Multimodal Commerce created from a restructured Department of Economic Development, and transfers powers, duties, and responsibilities with respect to multimodal commerce and corresponding department employees, equipment, facilities, funding, and statutory entities from the Department of Transportation and Development to such office and department. (gov sig)
- SB 574 CHABERT HOUSING  
Creates the My Safe Louisiana Home Program within the Louisiana Housing Corporation and provides for funding of the program. (7/1/15)
