SB 632 RISER TAX/TAXATION  
Authorizes the secretary of the Department of Revenue to establish a Solar Credit Secured Refund Pilot Program to allow taxpayers who are eligible to receive a solar credit refund to authorize their refunds to be paid directly to a properly secured third party lender. (gov sig)

Provides for a contradictory hearing for a motion to withdraw a guilty plea

HB 841 LEGER CORPORATIONS  
Provides for voting trusts as holders of limited liability company certificates

HB 863 DANAHAHAY TAX APPEALS/BOARD  
Authorizes and provides for the adjudication of certain state and local tax disputes by the Board of Tax Appeals

Directs the Department of Health and Hospitals to create the Practice and Regulation of Acupuncture and Oriental Medicine Review Committee.

Requests the Department of Health and Hospitals to study the most effective means to ensure the proper utilization of Attention Deficit Hyperactivity Disorder medications in Louisiana and to report its findings to the legislature.
