- SB 1 ALLAIN SERVITUDES
Provides relative to servitudes of natural drainage. (gov sig)
- SB 2 CLAITOR STATE POLICE RET FUND
Repeals provisions for payment to certain DROP participants of a retirement benefit calculated as if the persons had not participated in DROP. (gov sig)
- SB 3 ALARIO PUBLIC BUILDINGS/GROUNDS
Names the "Senator Chris Ullo Building". (gov sig)
- SB 4 ALARIO ROADS/HIGHWAYS
Names the new bridge across Caminada Pass to Grand Isle on LA 1 in Jefferson Parish the "Andy Valence Memorial Bridge". (8/1/15)
- SB 5 GUILLORY, ELBERT ROADS/HIGHWAYS
Designates the intersection of LA Hwy 182 and LA Hwy 358 in Opelousas as the "St. Landry Parish Memorial Intersection". (8/1/15)

Constitutional amendment to direct DHH to offer health insurance with essential health benefits to every legal resident of Louisiana whose income is at or below 138% of the federal poverty level. (2/3 - CA13s1(A))
- SB 11 LONG TAX/LOCAL
Authorizes the Sabine Parish Tourist and Recreation Commission to levy additional occupancy taxes on hotel rooms, motel rooms, and camping facilities if approved by parish voters. (8/1/15)

Provides for locations of sessions of the 25th Judicial District Court. (gov sig)

| SB | 76 | MORRISH | ASSESSORS | Authorizes the Jefferson Davis Parish Assessment District to provide for an automobile expense allowance for the assessor. (gov sig) |
| SB | 77 | KOSTELKA | MOTOR VEHICLES | Requires a motor vehicle repairman to disclose to customers that parts used in an auto body repair may not be new, original equipment manufacturer parts. (8/1/15) |

| SB | 83 | WHITE | COMMERCIAL REGULATIONS | Provides relative to exceptions from the issuance of provisional licenses to ex-offenders in order to work in certain fields. (8/1/15) |
| SB | 84 | PETERSON | EMPLOYMENT | Creates the Louisiana Family and Medical Leave Benefits Act. (see Act) (2/3-CA7s2.1) |
| SB | 85 | ADLEY | TAX/TAXATION | Constitutional amendment to exempt from ad valorem property taxes inventory held by manufacturers, distributors, and retailers and to prohibit adjustment of millages because of the implementation of the exemption. (2/3-CA13s1(A)) (1/1/16) |
| SB | 86 | PERRY | ETHICS | Provides relative to nepotism relating to school employees. (8/1/15) |
| SB | 87 | PERRY | ETHICS | Removes financial disclosure requirements for members of boards and commissions that do not earn compensation or per diem. (8/1/15) |
| SB | 88 | ADLEY | CONSERVATION | Provides for drilling units and authorizes the permitting of cross-unit wells. (8/1/15) |
| SB | 89 | ADLEY | TAX/TAXATION | Removes the refundable tax credit for ad valorem property taxes paid on natural gas held, used, or consumed in providing natural gas storage services or operating natural gas storage facilities. (gov sig) |
| SB | 90 | ADLEY | TAX/TAXATION | Prohibits all claims for and refunds of tax credits filed for tax years beginning during calendar year 2015, and defers such claims and refunds to tax years beginning during 2016. (gov sig) |
| SB | 91 | ADLEY | TAX/TAXATION | Changes certain refundable tax credits to nonrefundable tax credits. (See Act) |
| SB | 92 | SMITH, JOHN | ROADS/HIGHWAYS | Declares 65 miles per hour speed limit on portions of LA 12 and LA 27. (8/1/15) |
| SB | 93 | ADLEY | TAX/INCOME/PERSONAL | Prohibits the \$25 credit for educational expenses for each child attending elementary and secondary school if the tax deduction for payment of tuition and fees is taken. (gov sig) |
| SB | 94 | MORRELL | TAX/TAXATION | Provides relative to the LA New Markets Jobs Act. (gov sig) |
| SB | 95 | MORRELL | TAX/TAXATION | Authorizes certifications of motion picture investor tax credits for Indigenous Louisiana Productions which agree 75% of its expenditures for ATL services will be expended on Louisiana residents and that 75% of its jobs will employ Louisiana residents and provides special tax credit provisions for them. (gov sig) |
| SB | 96 | MORRELL | TAX/TAXATION | Limits all claims against income tax for motion picture investor tax credits filed during each fiscal year to \$300 million, but rolls over any remaining balance to future fiscal years. (7/1/15) |

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| SB | 97 | MORRELL | TAX/TAXATION | Authorizes certain movie memorabilia donations to CRT in lieu of a first processing transfer fee for a Hollywood South program to memorialize the movie industry in Louisiana. (7/1/15) |
| SB | 98 | MORRELL | TAX/TAXATION | Requires sellers of motion picture investor tax credits to qualify for and be included in a Public Registry of Motion Picture Investor Tax Credit Brokers. (1/1/16) |
| SB | 99 | MORRELL | TAX/TAXATION | Authorizes contracts for motion picture investor tax credit for five years, renewable for five more, for scripted television series if they agree to construct or lease production facilities in Louisiana and reach an agreement with LED on guaranteed expenditures and jobs for residents. (gov sig) |
| SB | 100 | MORRELL | TAX/TAXATION | Requires sworn affidavits of those submitting information for the creation of production audit reports for motion picture investor tax credits, regulates and limits production expenditures between related parties, and subjects related party transactions to review by the state inspector general. (gov sig) |
| SB | 101 | MORRELL | TAX/TAXATION | Requires the Louisiana Workforce Commission to provide information to LED and LDR to verify payroll and employment of Louisiana residents for purposes of the motion picture investor tax credit. (7/1/15) |
| SB | 102 | MORRELL | TAX/TAXATION | Prohibits certification for motion picture investor tax credits if expenditures for ATL services exceed 50% of total production expenditures. (1/1/16) |
| SB | 103 | MORRELL | TAX/TAXATION | Excludes certain expenditures as eligible for motion picture investor tax credits. (1/1/16) |
| SB | 104 | MORRELL | TAX/TAXATION | Limits the amount of motion picture investor tax credits which may be awarded on state-certified productions approved during a fiscal year to \$300 million, but rolls over any credits not awarded to future fiscal years. (7/1/15) |
| SB | 105 | MORRELL | TAX/TAXATION | Authorizes the recapture of disallowed tax credits from owners of entities created or organized for the primary purpose of receiving and/or selling motion picture investor tax credits. (gov sig) |
| SB | 106 | MORRELL | TAX/TAXATION | Requires recovery of motion picture investor tax credits issued in violation of the tax credit law or its administrative interpretation and those issued to an investor convicted of a criminal violation related to such tax credits. (gov sig) |
| SB | 107 | PEACOCK | WORKERS' COMPENSATION | Extends the benefit deadline in the Workers' Compensation Second Injury Fund. (gov sig) |
| SB | 108 | BUFFINGTON | HEALTH/ACC INSURANCE | Provides for the collection of co-insurance and deductibles by health insurance issuers. (8/1/15) |
| SB | 109 | JOHNS | MEDICAID | Provides for reporting measures for the Medicaid managed care program and the Louisiana Behavioral Health Partnership program. (gov sig) |
| SB | 110 | JOHNS | RAILROADS | Provides exemptions from audible warnings at certain railroad grade crossings. (gov sig) |
| SB | 111 | GALLOT | FUNDS/FUNDING | Creates the Out-of-State Sales Tax Collection Fund in the state treasury and dedicates certain proceeds from implementation as a result of a federal law which will require vendors located out-of-state to collect sales tax on their Internet, mail order, or other sales into the state. (gov sig) |
| SB | 112 | GALLOT | LOCAL OPTION | Provides for local option election for sale of liquor and wine in certain wards in Rapides Parish. (gov sig) |
| SB | 113 | GALLOT | PSYCHOLOGISTS | Provides relative to membership of the State Board of Examiners of Psychologists, qualifications of certain licensees, and maintenance of board documents and records. (8/1/15) |

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| SB | 114 | MILLS | LAW ENFORCEMENT | Provides for police service classification and discretionary standards of the deputy chief of police position in the city of St. Martinville. (8/1/15) |
| SB | 115 | MILLS | HEALTH CARE | Provides with respect to the practice of physician assistants. (gov sig) |
| SB | 116 | GALLOT | MUNICIPALITIES | Provides relative to the city of Alexandria municipal fire and police civil service system. (gov sig) |
| SB | 117 | SMITH, GARY | SEX OFFENSES | Provides relative to certain sex offenses. (8/1/15) |
| SB | 118 | ADLEY | TAX/SALES | Dedicates to the Better Highways and Higher Education Fund state sales tax proceeds collected each fiscal year as a result of a federal law requiring vendors located out-of-state to collect sales tax on their Internet and mail order sales. (gov sig) |
| SB | 119 | PERRY | LEGISLATION | Constitutional amendment to limit the number of constitutional amendments that may appear on a ballot. (2/3-CA13s1(A)) |
| SB | 120 | ADLEY | PUBLIC RECORDS | Provides relative to the records of the governor. (gov sig) |
| SB | 121 | AMEDEE | LEGISLATIVE AUDITOR | Provides relative to the legislative auditor. (gov sig) |
| SB | 122 | ADLEY | FUNDS/FUNDING | Provides for an increase in the base amount of mineral revenues state receives prior to annual deposit into the Budget Stabilization Fund. (2/3-CA7s10.3(A)(2)(b)) (gov sig) |
| SB | 123 | ADLEY | FUNDS/FUNDING | Constitutional amendment to provide, beginning Fiscal Year 2016-2017, for certain dedications from the Transportation Trust Fund. (2/3-CA13s1(A)) |
| SB | 124 | ADLEY | TAX/SALES | Repeals all exclusions and exemptions against all the statewide sales taxes. (7/1/16) |
| SB | 125 | ADLEY | TAX/AD VALOREM | Constitutional amendment to reduce 10-Year Industrial Exemptions originally granted before January 1, 2017, to 60% of the property originally exempted and extend the term for an additional two years. (2/3 - CA13s1(A)) |
| SB | 126 | ADLEY | TAX/LOCAL | Repeals tax credits for local inventory taxes paid. (gov sig) |
| SB | 127 | ADLEY | TAX EXEMPTIONS | Prohibits providing tax credits in Enterprise Zone contracts. (gov sig) |
| SB | 128 | MURRAY | TAX/LOCAL | Authorizes parishes and municipalities to levy and collect a tobacco tax. (gov sig) |
| SB | 129 | NEVERS | SCHOOLS | Authorizes a local public school district to enter into an agreement with a higher-performing district to manage and operate one or more of its low-performing schools. (gov sig) |
| SB | 130 | JOHNS | LOCAL FINANCE | Authorizes the governing authority of Calcasieu Parish to use a portion of the monies allocated from the Parish Transportation Fund to perform additional work within Calcasieu Parish. (8/1/15) |
| SB | 131 | JOHNS | GAMING | Provides that an elected public official can do business with gaming licensees as a non-key gaming employee. (gov sig) |
| SB | 132 | NEVERS | POSTSECONDARY ED | Provides for the reverse transfer of academic credits and the award of certain credits to veterans and their spouses. (gov sig) |

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| SB | 133 | PEACOCK | PARISHES | Provides criteria for parish governing authorities to consider when determining a heavily populated area within the unincorporated area of the parish for purposes of prohibiting, restricting, or regulating the shooting of firearms. | SB | 134 | PEACOCK | FAMILY LAW | Provides for parental authority of married persons, obligations of children, parents, and other ascendants, and provisional custody by mandate. (1/1/16) |
| SB | 135 | PEACOCK | HORSE RACING | Provides for the number of live racing days at eligible facilities located in Bossier Parish. (8/1/15) |
| SB | 136 | ALARIO | FUNDS/FUNDING | Provides relative to special funds in the state treasury. (gov sig) |
| SB | 137 | ADLEY | SERVITUDES | Provides relative to enclosed estates, right of passage, and use of levees for passage. (8/1/15) |
| SB | 138 | ALLAIN | TAX/AD VALOREM | Authorizes taxing authorities to decline to collect property tax on inventory held by manufacturers, distributors, and retailers if the taxing authority accepts a payment provided by law in lieu of the ad valorem taxes. (1/1/16) |

Suspends for the 2015-2016 Fiscal Year all excise tax exclusions, exemptions, deductions, and credits.
