SB 23 WARD SHERIFFS

Provides relative to payment of group insurance premiums for retired sheriffs and deputy sheriffs of the West Baton Rouge Parish Sheriff's Office. (8/1/15)

SB 27 BROOME DOMESTIC VIOLENCE

Prohibits expungement of a conviction for domestic abuse battery. (gov sig)

SB 73 MORRISH CORRECTIONAL FACILITIES

Defines a judicial agency for purposes of referring certain persons arrested for commission of a crime in housing or a temporary residence which is regulated by the Department of Public Safety and Corrections. (8/1/15)

SB 93 ADLEY TAX/INCOME/PERSONAL

Prohibits the \$25 credit for educational expenses for each child attending nonpublic elementary and secondary school if the tax deduction for payment of tuition and fees is taken. (gov sig)

SB 98 MORRELL TAX/TAXATION

Requires sellers of motion picture investor tax credits to qualify for and be included in a Public Registry of Motion Picture Investor Tax Credit Brokers. (1/1/16)

SB 100 MORRELL TAX/TAXATION

Requires: LED to engage independent auditors to prepare production expenditure verification reports for motion picture investor tax credits; sworn affidavits of those submitting information for the reports; regulates and limits expenditures between related parties and subjects them to review the state inspector general. (gov sig)

SB 101 MORRELL TAX/TAXATION

Requires the Louisiana Workforce Commission to provide information to LED and LDR to verify payroll and employment of Louisiana residents for purposes of the motion picture investor tax credit. (7/1/15)

SB 102 MORRELL TAX/TAXATION

Limits expenditures for ATL services eligible for motion picture investor tax credits to 50% of total production expenditures in the state. (1/1/16)

SB 103 MORRELL TAX/TAXATION

Excludes certain expenditures as eligible for motion picture investor tax credits. (1/1/16)

SB 105 MORRELL TAX/TAXATION

Authorizes the recapture of disallowed tax credits from owners of entities created or organized for the primary purpose of receiving and/or selling motion picture investor tax credits. (gov sig)

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SB 106 MORRELL TAX/TAXATION

Requires recovery of motion picture investor tax credits issued in violation of the tax credit law or its administrative interpretation and those issued to an investor convicted of a criminal violation related to such tax credits. (gov sig)

SB 155 DONAHUE TUITION

Constitutional amendment to authorize the postsecondary education management boards to establish tuition and fee amounts charged by institutions under their supervision and management. (2/3-CA13sl(A))

SB 181 ADLEY TAX/INCOME/PERSONAL

Repeals an income tax deduction for the net capital gains on the sale of a nonpublicly traded business commercially domiciled in Louisiana. (gov sig)

SB 187 CLAITOR TAX/TAXATION

Limits the alternative fuel tax credit to qualified clean-burning motor vehicle fuel property purchased and installed, or new motor vehicles purchased at retail, before July 1, 2015. (gov sig)

SB 198 HEITMEIER CHARITABLE GAMING

Provides relative to charitable bingo. (gov sig)

SB 234 DONAHUE TAX/TAXATION

Makes certain food businesses and any retail business except grocery stores and pharmacies with a certain number of employees ineligible for Enterprise Zone contracts. (gov sig)

SB 235 MURRAY ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

Provides relative to the regulation of alcoholic beverages. (1/1/16)

SB 271 WHITE TAX/TAXATION

Provides for equivalency of the special fuels tax with the gasoline tax on motor vehicles that operate on the highways using liquefied natural gas, liquefied petroleum gas, or compressed natural gas. (8/1/15)

Provides relative to credits and deposits into the "Water Help Program Fund" of the Sewerage and Water Board of New Orleans. (gov sig)

Provides relative to release of obligations of indebtedness by the Sewerage and Water Board of New Orleans. (gov sig)

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MORRISH SB 76 **ASSESSORS** Authorizes the Jefferson Davis Parish Assessment District to provide for an automobile expense allowance for the assessor. (gov sig) LAW ENFORCEMENT SB 114 **MILLS** Provides for police service classification and discretionary standards of the deputy chief of police position in the city of St. Martinville. (8/1/15) **FUNDS/FUNDING** SB 122 **ADLEY** Provides for an increase in the base amount of mineral revenues state receives prior to annual deposit into the Budget Stabilization Fund. 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SB 174 BROOME DOMESTIC VIOLENCE

Provides certain accommodations upon reasonable documentation presented by domestic abuse victims who lease residential dwellings. (8/1/15)

SB 177 ADLEY TAX/AD VALOREM

Constitutional amendment to add certain property tax exemptions and reductions and to provide with respect to tax credits associated with them; to dedicate the net state revenue increase to a Tax Credit Reduction Fund and provide for allocations from the fund; and to provide for appropriations to local tax authorities. (2/3-CA 13sl(A))

SB 217 GALLOT PUBLIC BUILDINGS/GROUNDS

Authorizes the transfer of certain state property in Rapides Parish. (8/1/15)

SB 237 MURRAY COURTS

Provides relative to the jurisdictional limitation of certain city courts and to the constable of the first city court of New Orleans and his deputies. (gov sig)

SB 240 LAFLEUR PUBLIC LANDS

Provides for the exchange of school lands by the Avoyelles Parish School Board. (gov sig)
