House Concurrent Resolutions 2nd Reading

- HCR 5 ST. GERMAIN NATURAL RESOURCES DEPT
Approves the 2015-2016 Atchafalaya Basin Annual Plan
- HCR 119 ABRAMSON COMMENDATIONS
Commends citizens who serve as jurors and designates May 11 through May 15, 2015, as Jury Appreciation Week in the state of Louisiana

Senate Concurrent Resolutions 3rd Reading and Final Passage

- SCR 34 HEITMEIER HEALTH CARE
Requests the Department of Health and Hospitals, the Department of Education, the Medicaid managed care organizations, and representatives of the Whole Child Initiative to work together to develop a plan to implement the Whole School, Whole Community, Whole Child model developed by the United States Centers for Disease Control and Prevention.

Senate Bills 3rd Reading and Final Passage

- SB 27 BROOME DOMESTIC VIOLENCE
Prohibits expungement of a conviction for domestic abuse battery. (gov sig)
- SB 102 MORRELL TAX/TAXATION
Limits expenditures for ATL services eligible for motion picture investor tax credits to 50% of total production expenditures in the state. (1/1/16)
- SB 106 MORRELL TAX/TAXATION
Requires recovery of motion picture investor tax credits issued in violation of the tax credit law or its administrative interpretation and those issued to an investor convicted of a criminal violation related to such tax credits. (gov sig)
- SB 155 DONAHUE TUITION
Constitutional amendment to authorize the postsecondary education management boards to establish tuition and fee amounts charged by institutions under their supervision and management. (2/3-CA13sl(A))
- SB 181 ADLEY TAX/INCOME/PERSONAL
Repeals an income tax deduction for the net capital gains on the sale of a nonpublicly traded business commercially domiciled in Louisiana. (gov sig)
- SB 187 CLAITOR TAX/TAXATION
Limits the alternative fuel tax credit to qualified clean-burning motor vehicle fuel property purchased and installed, or new motor vehicles purchased at retail, before July 1, 2015. (gov sig)
- SB 198 HEITMEIER CHARITABLE GAMING
Provides relative to charitable bingo. (gov sig)
- SB 234 DONAHUE TAX/TAXATION
Makes certain food businesses and any retail business except grocery stores and pharmacies with a certain number of employees ineligible for Enterprise Zone contracts. (gov sig)
- SB 235 MURRAY ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES
Provides relative to the regulation of alcoholic beverages. (1/1/16)
- SB 3 ALARIO PUBLIC BUILDINGS/GROUNDS
Names the "Senator Chris Ullo Building". (gov sig)
- SB 33 WALSWORTH ADMINISTRATION DIVISION
Places the office of telecommunications management within the office of technology services. (8/1/15)
- SB 56 DORSEY-COLOMB CHIROPRACTORS
Provides for the practice of chiropractic. (gov sig)
- SB 61 BUFFINGTON HEALTH SERVICES
Provides relative to hospital service districts. (gov sig)
- SB 131 JOHNS GAMING
Provides that an elected public official can do business with gaming licensees as a non-key gaming employee. (gov sig)

SB 167 BUFFINGTON MEDICAID
Provides relative to the Medical Assistance Program. (8/1/15)

SB 219 MURRAY EMPLOYMENT
Provides for equal pay regardless of sex and prohibits discrimination based upon sex. (8/1/15)

SB 66 SMITH, G. PUBLIC CONTRACTS
Extends time for ports to use the design-build method on certain construction projects. (8/1/15)

SB 87 PERRY ETHICS
Removes financial disclosure requirements for members of boards and commissions that do not earn compensation or per diem. (8/1/15)

SB 146 CLAITOR FUNDS/FUNDING
Provides relative to the Budget Stabilization Fund. (See Act)

SB 162 SMITH, G. PUBLIC CONTRACTS
Authorizes construction management at risk pilot program. (8/1/15)

SB 177 ADLEY TAX/AD VALOREM
Constitutional amendment to add certain property tax exemptions and reductions and to provide with respect to tax credits associated with them; to dedicate the net state revenue increase to a Tax Credit Reduction Fund and provide for allocations from the fund; and to provide for appropriations to local tax authorities. (2/3-CA 13sl(A))

SB 217 GALLOT PUBLIC BUILDINGS/GROUNDS
Authorizes the transfer of certain state property in Rapides Parish. (8/1/15)

SB 218 MURRAY FUNDS/FUNDING
Establishes a program to attract major events to the state and dedicates funds therefor. (7/1/15)

SB 240 LAFLEUR PUBLIC LANDS
Provides for the exchange of school lands by the Avoyelles Parish School Board. (gov sig)

HB 665 KLECKLEY TAX/SALES-USE, LOCAL
Excludes certain repairs on tangible personal property from local sales and use tax by certain taxing authorities in Calcasieu Parish
