Constitutional amendment to rename the Budget Stabilization Fund to the Budget and Transportation Stabilization Trust and to provide for use of monies in the fund, including the dedication of certain monies into the Transportation Trust Fund. (2/3s CA 13s 1 (A))

SB 206 NEVERS CIVIL PROCEDURE  
Provides the option of a right of direct action against the insurer alone when the insured is a small business employing fifty or fewer full-time employees. (8/1/15)
