Repeals an income tax deduction for the net capital gains on the sale of a nonpublicly traded business

> Requires corporations subject to Louisiana income or franchise tax which have either corporate gross revenues everywhere of \$8 billion or \$8 million of assets everywhere to file combined returns and limits their NOL deduction to 50% of tax liability. (gov sig)
