SR 208 MORRELL LAW ENFORCEMENT
Creates the Orleans Parish Law Enforcement Streamline and Accountability Commission.

HCR 228 JOHNSON, R. CONGRESS
Memorializes congress to reestablish a right-of-way through a wildlife refuge in order to provide access to property owned by the Avoyelles Parish School Board

HCR 229 ST. GERMAIN WATERWAYS
Urges and requests the U.S. Board on Geographic Names to name the entrance to Buffalo Cove in the Atchafalaya Basin as Skerrett Point

HB 451 SCHEXNAYDER BOARDS/COMMISSIONS
Provides relative to boards, commissions, authorities, districts, and like entities

SB 16 GUILLORY, E. RETIREMENT SYSTEMS
Provides for application of excess investment earnings of the state retirement systems. (2/3 - CA10s29) (6/30/15)

Provides for a hospital stabilization formula.

SB 41 ALLAIN CONSERVATION
Provides relative to the Louisiana Oilfield Site Restoration Law. (8/1/15)

SB 65 BUFFINGTON COLLEGES/UNIVERSITIES
Provides relative to postsecondary education management boards. (8/1/15)

SB 78 MILLS TAX/TAXATION
Provides the information to be submitted to the legislative fiscal information for the review of instruments relative to tax exemptions, exclusions, deductions, and credits.

SB 112 GALLOT LOCAL OPTION
Provides for a local option election for the sale of liquor and wine in certain areas of Rapides Parish. (gov sig)

SB 119 PERRY LEGISLATION
Constitutional amendment to limit the number of constitutional amendments that may appear on a ballot. (2/3-CA13s1(A))

SB 146 CLAITOR FUNDS/FUNDING
Provides relative to the Budget Stabilization Fund. (See Act)

SB 167 BUFFINGTON MEDICAID
Provides relative to the Medical Assistance Program. (8/1/15)

SB 177 ADLEY TAX/AD VALOREM
Constitutional amendment to add certain property tax exemptions and reductions and to provide with respect to tax credits associated with them; to dedicate the net state revenue increase to a Tax Credit Reduction Fund and provide for allocations from the fund; and to provide for appropriations to local tax authorities. (2/3-CA 13sl(A))

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- SB 181 ADLEY TAX/INCOME/PERSONAL
Repeals an income tax deduction for the net capital gains on the sale of a nonpublicly traded business commercially domiciled in Louisiana. (gov sig)
- SB 234 DONAHUE TAX/TAXATION
Makes certain food businesses and any retail business except grocery stores and pharmacies with a certain number of employees ineligible for Enterprise Zone contracts. (gov sig)
- SB 240 LAFLEUR PUBLIC LANDS
Provides for the exchange of school lands by the Avoyelles Parish School Board. (gov sig)
- SB 269 ADLEY TAX/TAXATION
Requires corporations subject to Louisiana income or franchise tax which have either corporate gross revenues everywhere of \$8 billion or \$8 million of assets everywhere to file combined returns and limits their NOL deduction to 50% of tax liability. (gov sig)

- HCR 15 MONTOUCET TAX/SALES & USE
Suspends annual state sales tax holidays until 60 days after adjournment of the 2016 Regular Session of the Legislature

House Bills 3rd Reading and Final Passage Subject to Call

- HB 47 ST. GERMAIN PROPERTY/COMMUNITY
Prohibits certain post-divorce earnable compensation in the Firefighters' Retirement System from being included in a former spouse's portion of community property
- HB 114 BURFORD CIVIL/ACTIONS
Authorizes the award of attorney fees relative to contempt of court
- HB 221 HALL INSURANCE/SURPLUS LINE
Provides relative to reporting requirements for the surplus lines insurance tax
- HB 355 PUGH TAX/SALES-USE, STATE
Provide for the collection of sales and use taxes due on sales made in Louisiana by a remote dealer
- HB 456 THIERRY TELECOMMUNICATIONS
Requires commercial mobile service providers and telecommunications carriers to disclose call location information to law enforcement agencies during emergency situations
- HB 733 HENSGENS MUNICIPAL/ANNEXATION
Provides relative to annexation procedures in the city of Abbeville
- HB 828 HENRY TAX/CORP FRANCHISE
Phases out corporation franchise tax

- SB 50 MURRAY LOCAL AGENCIES
Provides relative to release of obligations of indebtedness by the Sewerage and Water Board of New Orleans. (gov sig)
- SB 61 BUFFINGTON HEALTH SERVICES
Provides relative to hospital service districts. (gov sig)
- SB 93 ADLEY TAX/INCOME/PERSONAL
Prohibits the \$25 credit for educational expenses for each child attending nonpublic elementary and secondary school if the tax deduction for payment of tuition and fees is taken. (gov sig)
- SB 100 MORRELL TAX/TAXATION
Requires: LED to engage independent auditors to prepare production expenditure verification reports for motion picture investor tax credits; sworn affidavits of those submitting information for the reports; regulates and limits expenditures between related parties and subjects them to review by the state inspector general. (gov sig)
- SB 102 MORRELL TAX/TAXATION
Limits expenditures for ATL services eligible for motion picture investor tax credits to 50% of total production expenditures in the state. (1/1/16)

| SB | 106 | MORRELL | TAX/TAXATION | Requires recovery of motion picture investor tax credits issued in violation of the tax credit law or its administrative interpretation and those issued to an investor convicted of a criminal violation related to such tax credits. (gov sig) |
| SB | 250 | JOHNS | LAW ENFORCEMENT | Creates a pilot program (Statewide Motor Vehicle Theft and Uninsured Motorists Identification Program) involving the use of license plate recognition devices for certain purposes. (8/1/15) |
| SB | 272 | ERDEY | TAX/SALES | Exempts from local sales tax prosthetic devices prescribed by physicians for personal consumption or use, when the patient is covered by Medicaid or a Medicaid program administered by a third party on behalf of the state. (7/1/15) |
| HB | 1 | FANNIN | APPROPRIATIONS | Provides for the ordinary operating expenses of state government for Fiscal Year 2015-2016 |
| HB | 2 | ROBIDEAUX | CAPITAL OUTLAY | Provides for the comprehensive Capital Outlay budget |
| HB | 61 | CARMODY | STUDENT/TUITION | (Constitutional Amendment) Exempts public postsecondary education tuition and fees from requirements for imposing a new or increasing an existing fee and provides relative to the authority to set tuition and fees |
| HB | 69 | JAMES | COURTS/CITY | Provides for the collection of additional court costs in Baton Rouge City Court to fund technology enhancements |
| HB | 76 | WILLIAMS, A. | REAPPORTIONMENT/JUDGES | Provides for the election sections for the City Court of Baton Rouge and for the number of judges elected from such sections |
| HB | 119 | RITCHIE | TAX/TOBACCO TAX | Levies an additional tax on cigarettes and dedicates the proceeds of the tax |
| HB | 123 | THIBAUT | AUDITS/AUDITING | Provides relative to the threshold for certain audit requirements |
| HB | 204 | FOIL | CHILDREN/CARE | Provides relative to adult children with disabilities |
| HB | 218 | BROADWATER | TAX/CORP INCOME | Provides with respect to the net operating loss deduction for purposes of the corporate income tax |
| HB | 250 | LEGER | FUNDS/FUNDING | Authorizes additional deposits into the Workforce Training Rapid Response Fund and requires a private match for the use of the additional deposits |
| HB | 259 | THIERRY | TAX/INSURANCE PREMIUM | Levies a tax on the annual gross premiums for surplus lines of insurance |
| HB | 370 | BROADWATER | INSURANCE/GROUP-STATE | Establishes the Group Benefits Actuarial Committee and requires an annual actuary study on the premium rate structure and approval by the panel of recommended changes to the premium rates charged for members of the Office of Group Benefits |
| HB | 376 | HARRIS | PROCUREMENT | Grants public and private postsecondary institutions greater participation in receiving and monitoring contracts and federal grants |

HB	402	STOKES	TAX/INCOME TAX	Adds requirements for eligibility for the income tax credit for taxes paid in other states
HB	445	MACK	MOTOR VEHICLES	Provides relative to entities authorized to provide services related to motor vehicles
HB	449	ROBIDEAUX	TAX/TAXATION	Provides relative to calculation of the Louisiana apportionment percent and taxable capital for manufacturers of certain aircraft
HB	455	THIBAUT	WATERWAYS/LAKES	Provides with respect to the boundaries of False River
HB	501	ROBIDEAUX	TAX/TAXATION	Provides for a state and local sales and use tax exemption for certain aircraft manufactured in Louisiana
HB	528	LEGER	MUNICIPALITIES/NO	Authorizes the city of New Orleans to create a municipal revenue amnesty program
HB	566	FANNIN	FUNDS/FUNDING	Provides for the transfer and deposit on monies among state funds
HB	577	JACKSON	MUNICIPAL	Provides relative to extension or contraction of corporate limits of municipalities by means of petition and ordinance
HB	624	JACKSON	TAX/CORP INCOME	Reduces the amount of certain corporate income tax exclusions and deductions
HB	629	JACKSON	TAX CREDITS	Reduces income and corporation franchise tax credits
HB	635	JACKSON	TAX/TAX REBATES	Reduces all tax rebates
HB	638	IVEY	STATE AGENCIES	Provides for the collection of fees associated with payments to state agencies by credit cards, debit cards, or other forms of electronic payments
HB	690	LORUSSO	HOUSING/AUTHORITIES	Provides with respect to the Housing Authority of New Orleans
HB	721	IVEY	REVENUE SECRETARY	Provides relative to penalties collected by the Department of Revenue
HB	735	STOKES	TAX/INCOME TAX	Requires the withholding of individual income taxes from income earned by certain individuals for purposes of the motion picture investor tax credit
HB	746	MIGUEZ	ENVIRONMENT/WASTE TIRES	Provides for the waste tire program in the Department of Environmental Quality
HB	748	STOKES	TAX CREDITS	Provides relative to the motion picture investor tax credit and the motion picture infrastructure investor tax credit
HB	766	ADAMS	COLLEGES/UNIVERSITIES	Provides relative to the operations of public colleges and universities and exemptions from specified regulations
HB	769	BURRELL	DISTRICTS/REDEVELOPMENT	Creates the Shreveport Implementation and Redevelopment Authority
HB	800	FANNIN	APPROPRIATIONS/SUPPLEML	Provides for supplemental appropriations for Fiscal Year 2014-2015

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- HB 805 ADAMS TAX CREDITS
Provides for the carry forward rather than the refund of a certain portion of the tax credits for ad valorem taxes paid to local governments
- HB 823 BARROW DISTRICTS/ECONOMIC DEVEL
Provides relative to the Greenwell Springs-Airline Economic Development District in East Baton Rouge Parish
- HB 829 ROBIDEAUX TAX CREDITS
Provides relative to the motion picture investor tax credit
- HB 833 HENRY MOTOR VEHICLES
Provides with respect to the distribution and sale of vehicles
- HCR 8 MONTOUCET TAX/SALES-USE, ST-EXEMPT
Suspends the exemption for business utilities as to the 0.97% state sales and use tax levy
- HCR 104 DOVE FISHING/OYSTERS
Creates the Oyster Lease Moratorium Lifting Committee
- HCR 143 HARRISON FINANCIAL INSTITUTIONS
Relative to Louisiana insurance laws regulating both financial institutions and the unfair trade practice of tying banking products or services to insurance products
