| 3. HB237 | WILLMOTT | CHILDREN/NEWBORNS Provides for an official symbol to identify emergency care facilities designated in the Safe Haven Law |
| 4. HB323 | JACKSON | PUBLIC LANDS/STATE Authorizes the transfer of state property in Morehouse Parish |
| 5. HB377 | DANAHAY | REGISTRARS OF VOTERS Requires a notice of the retirement or resignation of a registrar of voters to be filed with the secretary of state |
| 6. HB475 | HOFFMANN | CHILDREN/DCFS Provides for the organization of the Department of Children and Family Services |
