2. **HB594** **JAY MORRIS** **SNAP/FOOD STAMPS** Requires legislative authorization for any waiver of SNAP work requirements for able-bodied adults without dependents
3. **HB596** **HUVAL** **INSURERS/AGENTS** Provides for notification and effectiveness of a material change in a contract between a health insurance issuer and a producer
4. **HB635** **HUNTER** **CRIME** Adds the use of unmanned aircraft systems as elements of certain crimes involving the invasion of privacy
5. **HB636** **LEOPOLD** **FISHING/OYSTERS** Amends the public oyster seed ground vessel permit
6. **HB663** **THIBAUT** **INSURERS/AGENTS** Requires notice to a non-captive insurance producer prior to an insurance company terminating the producer's appointment
7. **HB719** **HODGES** **CHILDREN/FOSTER CARE** Provides relative to transportation of children to be admitted to a treatment facility under a physician's emergency commitment certificate
8. **HB832** **SEABAUGH** **INSURANCE DEPARTMENT** Provides for exemptions relative to the Department of Insurance and certain provisions applicable to employment and criminal records
9. **HB868** **HUNTER** **ATHLETICS/TRAINERS** Authorizes public school governing authorities to require at least one coach for each sport offered by a public school to be certified in cardiopulmonary resuscitation
10. **HB898** **G.MILLER** **CAMPAIGN FINANCE DISCLOS** Changes the definition of motor vehicles relative to the prohibition on purchasing motor vehicles with campaign funds to provide that such prohibition does not apply to trailers
11. **HB899** **LEGER** **SCHOOLS/DISTRICTS** Provides relative to the allocation of local funds by the Orleans Parish School Board for schools transferred to the Recovery School District
