1. **HB361** **PYLANT** **CHILDREN/CARE** Provides penalties for persons operating early learning centers without a valid license
2. **HB369** **S.BISHOP** **REAPPORTIONMENT** Requires the submission of redistricting plans in a specified format to the secretary of state
3. **HB402** **P.SMITH** **STUDENTS** Authorizes the state Dept. of Education and the Dept. of Health and Hospitals to survey students regarding certain risk behavior associated with chronic health conditions
4. **HB414** **S.BISHOP** **SECRETARY OF STATE** Authorizes the secretary of state to provide for posting on his website information on persons who provide redistricting services
5. **HB439** **IVEY** **STUDENT/TUITION** Authorizes public postsecondary education management boards to increase tuition and provides for limitations and exceptions
6. **HB464** **S.BISHOP** **MINERALS** Provides for pipeline safety inspection fees

21. **HB815** **STOKES** **HUMAN REMAINS** Prohibits post-abortion harvesting of fetal remains and requires burial or cremation of such remains

23. **HB823** **HUNTER** **WATER/DRINKING WATER** Provides for heightened drinking water quality standards and increased enforcement of water system safety regulations in certain municipalities

6. **HB589** **BROADWATER** **LICENSING** Exempts certain vendors who sell trolling motors from licensing requirements
7. **HB695** **BROADWATER** **REVENUE DEPARTMENT** Provides relative to the types of debt the office of debt recovery is charged with collecting

8. **HB700** **STOKES** **FEES/LICENSES/PERMITS** Provides relative to fees assessed for certain functions performed by the office of public health
9. **HB785** **LEOPOLD** **DISTRICTS/NEIGHBORHOOD** Provides for the creation of neighborhood improvement and beautification districts in certain parishes
