| SB | 151 | CLAITOR | DISTRICT ATTORNEYS | Repeals certain provisions declared unconstitutional that regard attorney fees in lawsuits filed against public officials. (8/1/16) |
| SB | 152 | CLAITOR | COMMERCIAL REGULATIONS | Repeals provision that any person entering an alcoholic beverage outlet is deemed to consent to a search which was declared unconstitutional. (8/1/16) |
| SB | 154 | CLAITOR | CIVIL PROCEDURE | Repeals certain provisions relative to jury trials that were declared unconstitutional. (gov sig) |
| SB | 173 | SMITH, G. | JUDGES | Provides for the attorney general to provide legal representation to parish judges. (8/1/16) |
| SB | 196 | CORTEZ | CRIME/PUNISHMENT | Removes judge's discretion with regard to mandatory sentences for certain offenses involving the possession, use, or discharge of a firearm. (8/1/16) |
| SB | 203 | WARD | ATTORNEYS | Provides for certain penalties regarding the unauthorized practice of law. (8/1/16) |
| SB | 287 | WARD | LAW ENFORCEMENT | Provides for the revocation of P.O.S.T. certification for peace officers convicted of malfeasance in office. (8/1/16) |
| SB | 295 | PETERSON | GAMING | Provides relative to non-gaming economic development by the casino operator. (8/1/16) |

Directs the Department of Health and Hospitals to submit a report by May 1, 2016, and to add Adrenoleukodystrophy (ALD) to the newborn screening panel no later than January 1, 2017.

Provides for the payment of certain system administrative expenses. (6/10/16)

SB 15 MILLS STATE EMPLOYEE RET
Adds the Iberia Parish Levee, Hurricane and Conservation District to the system. (7/1/16)

SB 16 PEACOCK SHERIFFS PEN/RELIEF FUND
Provides for a benefit for survivors of members killed in the line of duty by an intentional violent act. (2/3 - CA10s29(F)) (6/30/16)

SB 49 LONG PUBLIC EMPLOYEES
Requires approval of the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget before certain salary increases in the executive branch are effective in the last ninety days of an administration. (7/1/16)

SB 228 LONG TAX/TAXATION
Recreates the Tax Free Shopping (Refund) Program set to terminate on July 1, 2017. (8/1/16)

SB 358 MORRISH POSTSECONDARY ED
Provides relative to the MediFund Board. (gov sig)

SB 3 PEACOCK FIREFIGHTERS RETIREMENT
Provides benefits for members hired on or after January 1, 2017. (6/30/16)

SB 106 BOUDREAUX VITAL STATISTICS
Provides for the elimination of the short-form birth certification card. (gov sig)

SB 109 BARROW EARLY CHILDHOOD ED
Provides for confidentiality of applications and client case records for child care assistance clients. (gov sig)

SB 192 JOHNS INSURANCE DEPARTMENT
Provides for the confidential treatment of papers, documents, reports, or evidence related to an investigation by the division of insurance fraud within the Department of Insurance. (8/1/16)

SB 199 GATTI INSURERS
Provides for prior approval by the commissioner of insurance for the merger of a domestic insurer or health maintenance organization. (8/1/16)

SB 246 LAFLEUR MUSEUMS
Transfers the Eddie G. Robinson Museum from the jurisdiction of the Department of State to the Board of Supervisors for the University of Louisiana System. (gov sig)

SB 250 LAFLEUR MUSEUMS
Removes the Germantown Colony Museum from the jurisdiction of the Department of State. (2/1/17)

SB 258 LUNEAU HEALTH/ACC INSURANCE
Provides for coverage for refills for prescription eye drops. (8/1/16)

SB 343 GATTI INSURANCE DEPARTMENT
Provides relative to the issuance of private letter rulings by the commissioner of insurance. (8/1/16)
