- SB 2 PEACOCK RETIREMENT SYSTEMS
Authorizes payments funded by state systems' experience accounts to certain retirees and beneficiaries. (2/3 - CA10s29(F)) (6/30/16)
- SB 28 PERRY MUNICIPALITIES
Provides relative to the qualifications of the chief of police for the town of Gueydan. (8/1/16)
- SB 40 PERRY TAX/TAXATION
Re-creates the income tax checkoff donation for Friends of Palmetto Island State Park. (gov sig)
- SB 48 ALLAIN LOCAL AGENCIES
Authorizes the St. Mary Parish Council, the town of Berwick and Recreation District No. 3 to enter into a contract assigning to the town the obligation to provide service in the area of the district annexed by the town. (gov sig)

Provides for a limitation relative to certain appropriations to the LSU Health Sciences Center of Shreveport. (7/1/17)
