- HB 189 BROWN, CHAD GAMBLING/VIDEO POKER  
Provides with respect to the closure of a restaurant at a qualified truck stop facility
- HB 196 LEGER GAMBLING/VIDEO POKER  
Provides with respect to fuel sales at qualified truck stop facilities
- HB 226 MORENO GAMBLING/VIDEO POKER  
Provides relative to revocation or suspension of a video draw poker device license for certain violations
- HB 232 STOKES HEALTH/MEDICAL TREATMENT  
Adds limitation of liability provisions to the Right To Try Act
- HB 272 SMITH, P. ETHICS
