Provides with respect to illegal carrying of weapons

Extends the cooperative endeavor program for use of the state's surface water resources

HB 490 LEBAS INSURANCE/HEALTH
Provides for the submission of a remittance advice by health insurers to pharmacists

Provides relative to the practice of telemedicine

HB 579 JOHNSON, R. DIETITIANS
Provides relative to the delivery of nutrition services

HB 585 BROADWATER LOBBYING
Requires lobbyists to report certain information

Provides relative to the delivery of nutrition services through telehealth

HB 640 LEGER COASTAL COMMISSION
Authorizes the Coastal Protection and Restoration Authority Board to develop a natural resource damages restoration bank program and oil spill compensation schedule

HB 758 PUGH MTR VEHICLE/INSPECTION
Provides relative to school bus inspection fees

HB 805 BROADWATER DISTRICTS/COMMUNICATIONS
Provides relative to communication districts

HB 809 SCHRODER CHILDREN/WELFARE SVCS
Provides with respect to representation of indigent or absent parents

HB 844 JAMES MTR VEHICLE/DRIVER LIC
Provides for an extension of driving privileges pending hearing by a court

HB 853 JOHNSON, R. PORTS/HARBORS/TERMINALS
Changes the composition of the Avoyelles Parish Port Commission

HB 856 HUVAL LIABILITY/CIVIL
Provides a limitation of liability for landowners who grant a right of passage to cemeteries

HB 924 COUSSAN MTR VEHICLE/LICEN PLATES
Creates the "Louisiana The Energy State" prestige license plate

HB 933 MILLER, G. CHILDREN/SUPPORT
Provides for the schedule of basic child support obligations

HB 978 DANAHA Y TAX/TAXATION
Provides for administration, disposition, enforcement, and adjudication of state and local taxes under the jurisdiction of the Board of Tax Appeals

Senate Concurrent Resolutions to be Adopted Subject to Call

SCR 29 CHABERT COASTAL RESOURCES
Requests the Coastal Protection and Restoration Financing Corporation to study the feasibility of employing financing techniques to convert future BP settlement payments into current assets to be deposited in and credited to the Coastal Protection and Restoration Fund.

SCR 32 COLOMB LEGIS POWERS/FUNCTIONS
Requires closed captioning of legislative proceedings that are broadcast.

SB 320 MORRELL DOMESTIC VIOLENCE
Provides for designated seating in a courtroom. (8/1/16)

SB 428 ALLAIN TAX/ENERGY
Dedicates certain funds to oilfield site-specific trust accounts in order to provide for oilfield site restoration. (gov sig)

SB 451 WARD COURTS
Provides relative to judicial treatment of certain arbitration awards. (gov sig)

SB 453 WHITE, BODI CRIME/PUNISHMENT
Adds Medicaid fraud to crimes governed by racketeering laws. (gov sig)

SB 57 BISHOP, W. GOVERNOR
Prohibits the increase in salary of unclassified employees in the executive branch for a period commencing on the gubernatorial election day and concluding on inauguration day. (gov sig)

SB 217 BISHOP, W. INSURANCE COMMISSIONER
Provides for the confidentiality of records disclosed to or by the commissioner of insurance during the course of an insurance receivership. (8/1/16)

SB 223 CLAITOR SPEECH/PATH/AUDIO
Provides relative the La. Board of Examiners for Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology.

SB 338 MARTINY SECURITIES
Provides for the protection of vulnerable adults from financial exploitation. (1/1/17)

SB 385 WALSWORTH MENTAL HEALTH
Adds certain legislators to the governing board of the Northeast Delta Human Services Authority. (8/1/16)

SB 122 BARROW ADVERTISING
Prohibits certain forms of untrue or misleading advertisements. (8/1/16)

SB 146 GATTI CAPITAL OUTLAY
Provides for institutions of higher education to first use capital outlay funding for deferred maintenance projects. (8/1/16)

SB 150 PERRY CRIMINAL PROCEDURE
Provides relative to mandatory bail hearings for certain defendants. (8/1/16)

SB 162 PETERSON DOMESTIC VIOLENCE
Provides relative to evidence admissible in certain civil actions involving domestic abuse and also provides relative to interspousal immunity. (8/1/16)

| SB | 196 | CORTEZ | CRIME/PUNISHMENT | Removes judge's discretion with regard to mandatory sentences for certain offenses involving the possession, use, or discharge of a firearm. (8/1/16) |
| SB | 242 | MILKOVICH | CIVIL PROCEDURE | Provides right of oral argument in contradictory hearings. (gov sig) |
| SB | 246 | LAFLEUR | MUSEUMS | Transfers the Eddie G. Robinson Museum from the jurisdiction of the Department of State to the Board of Supervisors for the University of Louisiana System. (gov sig) |
| SB | 250 | LAFLEUR | MUSEUMS | Removes the Germantown Colony Museum from the jurisdiction of the Department of State. (2/1/17) |
| SB | 267 | MORRELL | ENTERTAINMENT INDUSTRY | Provides relative to certain entities or organizations receiving capital outlay funding. (1/1/17) |

- HB 179 WHITE, MALINDA HUNTING
Adds "blaze pink" as an alternative to the hunter orange requirements
- HB 236 THIBAUT MOTOR VEHICLES
Provides grace period in order to pay certain taxes and fees related to motor vehicles for persons separating from active duty military service
- HB 588 JOHNSON, R. REVENUE/TAXATION DEPT
Reduces the fee charged to the Department of Children and Family Services and district public defender's offices for each tax offset claim
- HB 194 JAMES CRIMINAL/PROCEDURE
Provides for exemption of expungement fees in certain circumstances
- HB 385 HAZEL CRIME
Creates the crime of providing false, nonexistent, or incomplete declaration of residence for bail
- HB 688 LEBAS CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES
Adds substances to Schedules II and IV of the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances Law
