Requires closed captioning of legislative proceedings that are broadcast.

SCR 78 MILKOVICH CIVIL PROCEDURE

Provides relative to evidence admissible in certain civil actions involving domestic abuse and also provides relative to interspousal immunity. (8/1/16)

SB 163 PETERSON LEGISLATIVE SESSIONS
Provides that general subject, tax, and fiscal matters shall be heard during each regular legislative session. (2/3-CA13s1(A))

SB 164 PETERSON VOTERS/VOTING
Allows any person who is registered to vote to vote absentee by mail without rendering a reason for requesting an absentee ballot. (8/1/16)
