- SB 10 PEACOCK STATE POLICE RET FUND

- SB 163 PETERSON LEGISLATIVE SESSIONS  
Provides that general subject, tax, and fiscal matters shall be heard during each regular legislative session. (2/3-CA13s1(A))
- SB 164 PETERSON VOTERS/VOTING  
Allows any person who is registered to vote to vote absentee by mail without rendering a reason for requesting an absentee ballot. (8/1/16)
- SB 192 JOHNS INSURANCE DEPARTMENT  
Provides for the confidential treatment of papers, documents, reports, or evidence related to an investigation by the division of insurance fraud within the Department of Insurance. (8/1/16)
- SB 246 LAFLEUR MUSEUMS  
Transfers the Eddie G. Robinson Museum from the jurisdiction of the Department of State to the Board of Supervisors for the University of Louisiana System. (gov sig)
- SB 250 LAFLEUR MUSEUMS  
Removes the Germantown Colony Museum from the jurisdiction of the Department of State. (2/1/17)
- SB 267 MORRELL ENTERTAINMENT INDUSTRY  
Provides relative to certain entities or organizations receiving capital outlay funding. (1/1/17)
