3. **HB487** **T.LANDRY** **MOTOR VEHICLES** Relative to fraudulent or fictitious identification credentials
4. **HB510** **L.HARRIS** **HIGHWAYS/EXPRESSWAYS** Designates a portion of Highway 1 in Alexandria as the "Deputy Marshal Glen Denning DeVanie Memorial Highway"
