8. **HB361** **IVEY** **TAX/CORP FRANCHISE** Phases-out the corporation franchise tax beginning January 1, 2019
9. **HB362** **IVEY** **TAX CREDITS** Provides with respect to income and corporation franchise tax credits
10. **HB363** **IVEY** **TAX/CORP INCOME** Caps the amount of losses a taxpayer may claim on certain tax returns for the net operating loss deduction and repeals the deduction for certain wage expenses
11. **HB364** **IVEY** **TAX/SEVERANCE TAX** Provides with respect to the rate and base for the state tax on certain natural resources severed from the soil or water
12. **HB413** **LEGER** **INDIGENT DEFENSE** Provides relative to the funding of public defenders
