Senate Bills on Second Reading to be Referred

- SB 240 RISER TAX/INCOME/PERSONAL
Exempts flood victims from paying state individual income tax for the 2017 tax year. (gov sig)
- SB 241 JOHNS TAX EXEMPTIONS
Restores the sales and use tax exemption for dental devices. (gov sig)
- SB 242 LUNEAU TAX/INCOME/CORPORATE
Provides for a corporate income tax deduction for certain dividend income received by regulated entities. (1/1/18)

- SB 16 CLAITOR JUVENILE JUSTICE
Provides relative to certain juveniles sentenced to life without parole. (gov sig)
- SB 52 LONG SHERIFFS
Provides relative to payment of group insurance for retired sheriffs and deputy sheriffs of the Natchitoches Parish Sheriff's Office. (8/1/17)
- SB 64 GATTI ANIMALS
Provides for animal shelter operating procedures and training requirements and authorizes animal shelters to post pictures of animals on a social media account or website. (8/1/17)
- SB 86 PERRY PARISHES
Permits the governing authorities of certain parishes to employ its own attorney to represent it generally. (gov sig)
- SB 147 RISER MILITARY AFFAIRS
Provides relative to the Louisiana National Guard. (gov sig)
- SB 195 CORTEZ ANIMALS
Provides relative to the suspension of racing privileges. (8/1/17)
- SB 213 SMITH, G. DISTRICT ATTORNEYS
Provides relative to health insurance for certain retired district attorneys. (8/1/17)
- SB 234 LAFLEUR CRIMINAL PROCEDURE
Provides relative to conditions of providing a property bond for purposes of bail. (gov sig)

- SB 22 PEACOCK TAX/TAXATION
Provides for items eligible for the 2nd Amendment Sales Tax Holiday. (8/1/17)
- SB 25 MORRELL TAX/INCOME/PERSONAL
Sunsets the individual income tax education credit. (gov sig)

- SB 26 MORRELL TAX EXEMPTIONS
Constitutional amendment to prohibit contracts under the industrial property tax exemption program from exempting millages related to school funding. (2/3 - CA13s1(A))
- SB 33 MORRELL TAX/TAXATION
Eliminates sunset provision on credit for taxes paid in other states. (gov sig)
- SB 48 MORRELL TAX/TAXATION
Provides for the termination of the credit for purchase of qualified recycling equipment or service contracts. (gov sig)
- SB 174 MORRELL TAX/TAXATION
Provides for a deduction for individual and corporate income tax for certain disaster payments. (gov sig)
- SB 175 MORRELL TAX/INCOME/PERSONAL
Provides for a deduction for certain casualty losses arising from a major disaster. (gov sig)
- SB 182 MORRELL TAX/AD VALOREM
Provides for the tax credit for ad valorem taxes paid on inventory by taxpayers included in one consolidated federal income tax return. (gov sig)

- SB 211 SMITH, G. CRIME/PUNISHMENT
Creates the crime of engaging in life safety and property protection contracting without authority. (8/1/17)
