- SCR 48 MILKOVICH STATE AGENCIES
Requires state agencies to include on their website information regarding any properties rented by the agency. (gov sig)
- SCR 49 JOHNS LEGIS POWERS/FUNCTIONS
Recognizes May 13, 2017, as Louisiana Firefighters' Appreciation Day and commends all firefighters across the state for their dedication to public safety, and for their service to the citizens of Louisiana and the United States of America.
- SCR 50 JOHNS COMMENDATIONS
Recognizes and expresses appreciation for the Louisiana Dental Association and Dental Lifeline Network - Louisiana's Donated Dental Services Program.
- SCR 51 TARVER COMMENDATIONS
Commends Pastor James C. Birdsong Jr. on his numerous accomplishments.

Authorizes the state fire marshal to purchase a specified group insurance policy for the benefit of certain volunteer members of fire companies

Provides relative to servitudes of natural drainage. (gov sig)
- SB 109 CLAITOR PRESCRIPTION
Provides for the suspension of prescription. (gov sig)
- SB 128 MILKOVICH CRIME/PUNISHMENT
Prohibits cutting, resection, excision, harvesting, or removal of a body part, organ, or tissue of an aborted unborn child for sale, commerce, transport, research, or profit. (gov sig)
- SB 129 ALLAIN SERVITUDES
Provides relative to compensation and indemnity for right and servitude of passage on certain waterways. (8/1/17)
- SB 142 CLAITOR CRIMINAL JUSTICE
Eliminates the death penalty. (8/1/17)
- SB 146 CLAITOR CRIME/PUNISHMENT
Provides relative to the Habitual Offender Law. (8/1/17)
- SB 151 WHITE, BODI HOMELAND SECURITY
Provides for the Interstate Emergency Management Assistance Compact. (gov sig)
- SB 185 LUNEAU CIVIL PROCEDURE
Provides relative to physical or mental examinations of certain persons. (8/1/17)
- SB 212 SMITH, G. LAW ENFORCEMENT
Provides relative to peace officer training requirements. (8/1/17)
- SB 222 ERDEY PUBLIC EMPLOYEES
Provides benefits for firemen and law enforcement officers who suffer a catastrophic injury resulting in permanent and total disability caused by an individual with the specific intent to kill an officer while the officer is engaged in the performance of his official duties. (gov sig)

Senate Resolutions 3rd Reading and Final Passage

SR 39 MILKOVICH RETIREMENT SYSTEMS
Urges and requests the systems to report certain investment information including amounts paid to investment professionals.

Senate Bills 3rd Reading and Final Passage

SB 7 PEACOCK STATE POLICE RET FUND
Provides for benefits for survivors of members killed in the line of duty by an intentional act of violence. (2/3 - CA10s29(F)) (6/30/17)

SB 8 PEACOCK RETIREMENT SYSTEMS
Provides for correction of membership and enrollment errors in the state and statewide retirement systems. (2/3 - CA10s29(F)) (6/30/17)

SB 11 PEACOCK RETIREMENT SYSTEMS
Provides for the incorporation of the Louisiana School Employees' Retirement System into the Teachers' Retirement System of Louisiana. (7/1/17)

SB 15 HEWITT LEVEES
Repeals provision that prohibits a commissioner of the St. Tammany Levee, Drainage and Conservation District, whose term is expired, from continuing to serve or vote. (gov sig)

SB 20 WARD PORTS/HARBORS/TERMINALS
Provides relative to meetings, election of officers, and per diem for members of the Greater Baton Rouge Port Commission. (8/1/17)

SB 23 ALARIO ROADS/HIGHWAYS
Designates the new bridge across Goose Bayou on LA 45 in Jefferson Parish as the "Jules Nunez Bridge". (8/1/17)

SB 24 MORRELL TAX EXEMPTIONS
Exempts diapers and feminine hygiene products from state and local sales and use tax. (See Act)

SB 27 MORRELL TAX EXEMPTIONS
Constitutional amendment to exempt diapers and feminine hygiene products from state sales and use tax. (2/3 - CA13s1(A))

SB 61 ALLAIN TAX/AD VALOREM
Constitutional amendment to authorize local economic development authorities or districts to enter into contracts to exempt offshore vessels from ad valorem taxation. (2/3 - CA13s1(A))

SB 71 DONAHUE TOPS
Provides relative to TOPS award amounts. (gov sig)

SB 77 LAMBERT WILDLIFE/FISHERIES DEPT
Allows the use of gill nets for taking of shad as bait fish with certain limitations. (8/1/17)

SB 90 ERDEY POSTSECONDARY ED
Provides relative to scholarships for children of certain law enforcement officers and other investigative employees killed or permanently disabled in the line of duty. (gov sig)

SB 93 MILLS TAX/TAXATION
Excludes from repairs to tangible personal property certain preparation and painting of certain aircraft for purposes of sales and use tax aircraft having an FAA registration address outside the state. (7/1/17)

SB 94 SMITH, G. ROADS/HIGHWAYS
Designates portions of certain state highways. (8/1/17)

SB 102 JOHNS FUNDS/FUNDING
Creates and provides for Louisiana Educational Workforce Training Fund to provide opportunities for educational training in the Louisiana Community and Technical College System. (gov sig)

SB 103 RISER WATER/WATERWAYS
Provides for approval of rules and regulations of a game and fish commission. (8/1/17)

SB 112 WHITE, BODI PROCUREMENT CODE
Provides relative to the execution of performance based energy efficiency contracts. (8/1/17)

- SB 125 THOMPSON PUBLIC LANDS
Authorizes the sale of certain property in Tensas Parish. (gov sig)
- SB 127 THOMPSON MOTOR VEHICLES
Prohibits certain coverings and devices from obstructing a license plate. (8/1/17)
- SB 148 CHABERT PORTS/HARBORS/TERMINALS
Creates the Waterway Dredging and Deepening Priority Program. (7/1/17)
- SB 150 CHABERT TAX/TAXATION
Provides for the Ports of Louisiana tax credits. (gov sig)
- SB 180 MORRELL TAX EXEMPTIONS
Restores the sales and use tax exemption for medical devices. (gov sig)
- SB 237 CORTEZ BONDS
Provides relative to revenue bonds of the Lafayette Public School Board. (gov sig)

Senate Bills 3rd Reading and Final Passage Subject to Call

- SB 16 CLAITOR JUVENILE JUSTICE
Provides relative to certain juveniles sentenced to life without parole. (gov sig)
- SB 25 MORRELL TAX/INCOME/PERSONAL
Sunsets the individual income tax education credit. (gov sig)
- SB 26 MORRELL TAX EXEMPTIONS
Constitutional amendment to prohibit contracts under the industrial property tax exemption program from exempting millages related to school funding. (2/3 - CA13s1(A))
- SB 33 MORRELL TAX/TAXATION
Eliminates sunset provision on credit for taxes paid in other states. (gov sig)
- SB 48 MORRELL TAX/TAXATION
Provides for the termination of the credit for purchase of qualified recycling equipment or service contracts. (gov sig)
- SB 174 MORRELL TAX/TAXATION
Provides for a deduction for individual and corporate income tax for certain disaster payments. (gov sig)
- SB 175 MORRELL TAX/INCOME/PERSONAL
Provides for a deduction for certain casualty losses arising from a major disaster. (gov sig)
