Revises terminology referring to the deaf and hard of hearing

HB 266 CONNICK LEVEES/BDS & DISTRICTS
Provides for term limits for members of the nominating committee of certain flood protection authorities

HB 272 HOLLIS ELECTIONS/RECALL
Provides relative to recall elections

HB 302 HARRIS, L. PROBATION
Increases the maximum amount of parole supervision fees and provides relative to the use of the funds

HB 333 JEFFERSON REVENUE DEPARTMENT
Authorizes the secretary of the Dept. of Revenue to require the filing of electronic tax returns and the payment of taxes by electronic funds transfer

HB 351 MILLER, G. CONSTITUTION/AMENDMENT
(Constitutional Amendment) Prohibits, subject to certain exceptions, a person convicted of a felony from holding elective or appointive office

HB 415 LEGER CIVIL/ACTIONS
Enacts the "Allen Toussaint Legacy Act" for the purpose of creating an individual property right of identity

HB 425 MAGEE TAX CREDITS
Removes the restriction against taxes paid under protest concerning claims for the ad valorem tax credit for certain offshore vessels

Provides relative to confidentiality of certain taxpayer information

HB 618 GAROFALO COASTAL RESOURCES
Authorizes the Coastal Protection and Restoration Financing Corporation to finance payments from the RESTORE Act and Natural Resources Damages Act

Requires proof of identification from parents for an unemancipated minor child to obtain an abortion based upon parental consent and requires court-ordered counseling if it is suspected that the minor is a victim of criminal sexual exploitation. (8/1/17)

Creates the Task Force on Secure Care Standards and Auditing.

SB 251 LAFLEUR BONDS
Authorizes the securitization of the economic damage portion of the Deepwater Horizon income stream.
(gov sig)

SB 2 MORRELL EMPLOYMENT
Provides that the Louisiana Equal Pay Act be applicable to men and private employers and requires government contractors to verify equal pay practices. (8/1/17)

SB 11 PEACOCK RETIREMENT SYSTEMS
Provides for the incorporation of the Louisiana School Employees' Retirement System into the Teachers' Retirement System of Louisiana. (7/1/17)

SB 25 MORRELL TAX/INCOME/PERSONAL
Sunsets the individual income tax education credit. (gov sig)

SB 26 MORRELL TAX EXEMPTIONS
Constitutional amendment to prohibit contracts under the industrial property tax exemption program from exempting millages related to school funding. (2/3 - CA13s1(A))

SB 27 MORRELL TAX EXEMPTIONS
Constitutional amendment to exempt diapers and feminine hygiene products from state sales and use tax. (2/3 - CA13s1(A))

SB 29 MORRELL TAX EXEMPTIONS
Provides relative to the sales and use tax exemption for antique airplanes. (7/1/17)

SB 33 MORRELL TAX/TAXATION
Eliminates sunset provision on credit for taxes paid in other states. (gov sig)

SB 35 COLOMB CONTROL DANGER SUBSTANCE
Provides exemptions from arrest and prosecution to persons lawfully in possession of medical marijuana.
(gov sig)

SB 38 MORRELL COUNSELING/GUIDANCE
Provides with respect to mental health counselors. (gov sig)

SB 48 MORRELL TAX/TAXATION
Provides for the termination of the credit for purchase of qualified recycling equipment or service contracts. (gov sig)

SB 80 BISHOP, W. TRAFFIC
Authorizes civilian traffic control officer to investigate certain traffic accidents in certain parishes. (8/1/17)

SB 114 APPEL INTERNET
Provides for free broadband Internet at public airports. (8/1/17)

SB 121 WARD CIVIL PROCEDURE
Provides relative to terminology of court-ordered and other mandatory examinations in civil and administrative matters and claims. (gov sig)

SB 142 CLAITOR CRIMINAL JUSTICE
Eliminates the death penalty. (8/1/17)

SB 146 CLAITOR CRIME/PUNISHMENT
Provides relative to the Habitual Offender Law. (8/1/17)

SB 174 MORRELL TAX/TAXATION
Provides for a deduction for individual and corporate income tax for certain disaster payments. (gov sig)

SB 175 MORRELL TAX/INCOME/PERSONAL
Provides for a deduction for certain casualty losses arising from a major disaster. (gov sig)

SB 178 MORRELL TAX/TAXATION
Establishes termination dates for certain tax credits and incentive programs administered by the Department of Economic Development. (gov sig)
