SCR 102 WARD LEGISLATORS
Affirms the need for civility in political discourse and debate as a fundamental requirement for effective representative democracy and governing.

HB 2 ABRAMSON CAPITAL OUTLAY
Provides for the comprehensive Capital Outlay budget

HB 117 FOIL TOPS
Raises the minimum grade point average required for initial eligibility for a Taylor Opportunity Program for Students (TOPS) Opportunity Award

HB 119 IVEY BUDGETARY PROCEDURES
Establishes the Louisiana Fiscal Transparency Website as a source of information for state expenditures

HB 189 DEVILLIER CAPITAL OUTLAY
Provides relative to capital outlay reform

HB 205 BOUIE PARDON/PAROLE
Provides relative to the length of time certain applicants are required to wait before applying for a pardon or commutation of sentence

HB 234 ZERINGUE CAPITAL OUTLAY
Provides relative to the local match requirements for non-state entities applying for capital outlay funding

HB 269 HARRIS, L. COLLEGES/UNIVERSITIES
Provides for free expression on college campuses

HB 353 STOKES TAX/INCOME TAX
(Constitutional Amendment) Eliminates the income tax deduction for federal income taxes paid for purposes of computing individual income taxes and the references to the maximum amount of individual income tax rates and brackets

HB 356 IVEY TAX/CORP INCOME
(Constitutional Amendment) Provides for flat income tax rates and eliminates the income tax deduction for federal income taxes paid for purposes of calculating corporate income tax liability

HB 389 CARMODY UTILITIES
Authorizes the commissioner of conservation of the Louisiana Department of Natural Resources to enforce the La. Underground Utilities and Facilities Damage Prevention (OneCall) law as it applies to pipelines

HB 396 DWIGHT TAX/SALES-USE, ST-EXEMPT
Provides for the effectiveness and applicability of the state sales and use tax exclusion for sales of gold, silver, or numismatic coins, and platinum, gold, or silver bullion

HB 436 TALBOT DRUGS/PRESCRIPTION
Requires drug manufacturers to provide information regarding prescription drug prices

HB 445 SEABAUGH TAX/AD VALOREM TAX
Authorizes and provides for cooperative endeavor agreements between local governmental subdivisions and other entities that may require payments in lieu of ad valorem taxes

HB 461 BISHOP, S. TAX/SEVERANCE-EXEMPTION
Provides for severance tax exemptions for certain inactive and orphan wells

HB 486 JOHNSON CHILDREN/ABUSE
Provides relative to the state central registry for child abuse and neglect

HB 501 STOKES TAX/INCOME TAX
Changes the rates and brackets for purposes of calculating individual income tax liability and eliminates certain deductions and credits

HB 534 JAMES TAX/TAX REBATES
Authorizes a rebate for taxpayers who donate to certain higher education scholarship and grant programs

- SB 2 MORRELL EMPLOYMENT
Provides that the Louisiana Equal Pay Act be applicable to men and private employers and requires government contractors to verify equal pay practices. (8/1/17)
- SB 11 PEACOCK RETIREMENT SYSTEMS
Provides for the incorporation of the Louisiana School Employees' Retirement System into the Teachers' Retirement System of Louisiana. (7/1/17)
- SB 26 MORRELL TAX EXEMPTIONS
Constitutional amendment to prohibit contracts under the industrial property tax exemption program from exempting millages related to school funding. (2/3 - CA13s1(A))
- SB 27 MORRELL TAX EXEMPTIONS
Constitutional amendment to exempt diapers and feminine hygiene products from state sales and use tax. (2/3 - CA13s1(A))
- SB 29 MORRELL TAX EXEMPTIONS
Provides relative to the sales and use tax exemption for antique airplanes. (7/1/17)
- SB 33 MORRELL TAX/TAXATION
Eliminates sunset provision on credit for taxes paid in other states. (gov sig)
- SB 35 COLOMB CONTROL DANGER SUBSTANCE
Provides exemptions from arrest and prosecution to persons lawfully in possession of medical marijuana. (gov sig)
- SB 48 MORRELL TAX/TAXATION

Authorizes civilian traffic control officer to investigate certain traffic accidents in certain parishes. (8/1/17)

Authorizes the state Department of Education and the Louisiana Department of Health to survey students regarding certain risk behavior associated with chronic health conditions. (gov sig)
