1. **HB12** **BARRAS** **BUDGETARY CONTROLS** Provides for changes in the expenditure limit calculation (Item #12)
2. **HB29** **BARRAS** **BUDGETARY PROCEDURES** Establishes the Louisiana Checkbook website to provide transparency of state fiscal information (Item #11)
3. **HB10** **JAMES** **TAX/INCOME TAX** Modifies the term "federal income tax liability" to include certain federal net disaster losses (Item #9)

13. **HB22** **SHADOIN** **TAX/CORP INCOME** Reduces the amount of certain corporate income tax deductions and provides for continued effectiveness of reductions to certain corporate income tax deductions and exclusions (Item #4)
