HOUSE BILLS ON FINAL PASSAGE - [10 items]

1. **HB10** **JAMES** **TAX/INCOME TAX** Modifies the term "federal income tax liability" to include certain federal net disaster losses (Item #9)
2. **HB24** **P.SMITH** **TAX/SALES-USE, STATE** Expands the Annual Louisiana Second Amendment Weekend Holiday exemption and repeals other state sales tax holidays (Item #7)
3. **HB27** **P.SMITH** **TAX** Increases the tax on certain telecommunication devices and services (Item #10)
4. **HB28** **P.SMITH** **TAX** Increases the tax on certain telecommunication devices and services and levies a tax on prepaid mobile devices and prepaid mobile device cards (Item #10)
5. **HB2** **BACALA** **MEDICAID** Provides for Medicaid eligibility determination functions and Medicaid fraud detection and prevention (Items #14 and 15)
6. **HB3** **HOFFMANN** **MEDICAID** Provides for a work and community engagement initiative within the Medicaid program (Item #13)
7. **HB8** **LEGER** **TAX/INCOME TAX** Reduces the amount of the individual income tax deduction for excess federal itemized personal deductions (Item #6)
8. **HB14** **LEGER** **TAX CREDITS** Provides relative to the individual income tax credit for taxes paid to other states (Item #5)
9. **HB16** **LEGER** **TAX/TAX REBATES** Reduces the amount of the rebate for the Competitive Projects Payroll Incentive Program and provide for continued effectiveness of reductions in the amount of certain rebates (Item #3)
10. **HB22** **SHADOIN** **TAX/CORP INCOME** Reduces the amount of certain corporate income tax deductions and provides for continued effectiveness of reductions to certain corporate income tax deductions and exclusions (Item #4)
