SR 14 SMITH, J. COMMENDATIONS

Provides for administration of incentive rebates under the Quality Jobs and Enterprise Zone programs. (Items #21 and 27)(gov sig)

SB 4 LAFLEUR FUNDS/FUNDING

Provides relative to the transfer, dedication, use, investment, and appropriation of funds in the state treasury. (Item #10) (gov sig)

SB 5 LAFLEUR BONDS

Authorizes the securitization of the economic damage portion of the Deepwater Horizon income stream. (Item #30) (gov sig)

SB 7 MORRELL TAX/TAXATION

Makes permanent reforms to the credit for individual income taxes paid in other states. (Item #17) (gov sig)

SB 8 MORRELL TAX/TAXATION

Defines the term dealer for purposes of collecting and remitting use tax on remote sales. (Item #26) (gov sig)

SB 13 WARD FISCAL CONTROLS

Provides relative to reporting of state expenditures through the fiscal transparency website. (Item #32) (7/1/18)

SB 15 DONAHUE BUDGET PROCEDURE

Provides for annual incentive expenditure program analysis. (Item #21) (gov sig)

SB 20 RISER FUNDS/FUNDING

Provides relative to the Workers' Compensation Administrative Fund. (Item #11) (gov sig)

SB 2 CLAITOR FUNDS/FUNDING

Provides for the dedication of certain local avails of the automobile rental tax collected in East Baton Rouge Parish. (Item #11)(7/1/18)

SB 6 LUNEAU TAX/TAXATION

Makes permanent reductions to credits and rebates under the Enterprise Zone, Quality Jobs, and Competitive Project Payroll Incentive programs. (Items #26 and 27) (gov sig)

SB 10 MORRELL TAX/INCOME/PERSONAL

Increases the earned income tax credit. (Item #21)(See Act)

SB 16 MORRELL TAX/AD VALOREM

Terminates the credit for ad valorem tax on offshore vessels. (Item #21)(8/1/18)

SB 18 MORRELL TAX/TAXATION

Creates a tax credit registry for tax credits with carryover provisions. (Item #21) (gov sig)

SB 19 CARTER, T. FUNDS/FUNDING

Repeals the termination date on the New Orleans Ferry Fund and dedicates a portion of the truck and trailer fees collected in Jefferson Parish into the Jefferson Parish Maintenance and Improvement Fund. (Item #10 and 11) (See Act)

### **Instruments Pending Senate Conference**

SCR 4 ALLAIN TAX/ENERGY

Requests the Louisiana State University Center for Energy Studies, Louisiana State University Public Administration Institute, and the Louisiana Tax Institute to analyze mineral revenues, taxes, and exemptions and to submit a written report of its findings to the legislature.
