SR 25 CLAITOR CONDOLENCES

SB 1 ALLAIN FUNDS/FUNDING

Provides for the transfer, deposit, and use of monies among state funds.(7/1/18)

SB 4 LAFLEUR FUNDS/FUNDING

Provides relative to the transfer, dedication, use, investment, and appropriation of funds in the state treasury. (Item #10) (gov sig)

SB 5 LAFLEUR BONDS

Authorizes the securitization of the economic damage portion of the Deepwater Horizon income stream. (Item #30) (gov sig)

SB 7 MORRELL TAX/TAXATION

Makes permanent reforms to the credit for individual income taxes paid in other states. (Item #17) (gov sig)

SB 18 MORRELL TAX/TAXATION

Creates a tax credit registry for tax credits with carryover provisions. (Item #21) (gov sig)

SB 22 MORRELL LEGISLATION

Constitutional amendment to eliminate the origination clause which requires that all revenue raising measures originate in the La. House of Representatives. (2/3 - CA13s1(A))

SB 23 MORRELL TAX/TAXATION

Changes certain rebates to nonrefundable tax credits. (gov sig)

Provides for the Omnibus Bond Act (Item #9)

HB 12 LEGER TAX/SALES & USE

HB 18 JACKSON TAX CREDITS

Provides relative to the individual income tax credit for taxes paid to other states (Item #17)

HB 28 ABRAMSON CAPITAL OUTLAY

SCR 4 ALLAIN TAX/ENERGY

Requests the Louisiana State University Center for Energy Studies, Louisiana State University Public Administration Institute, and the Louisiana Tax Institute to analyze mineral revenues, taxes, and exemptions and to submit a written report of its findings to the legislature.
