Prohibits medical treatment furlough to any offender serving a sentence for a conviction of first degree murder or second degree murder. (8/1/18)

Extends creation of the Louisiana Supply Chain and Transportation Council.

Requests the Department of Children and Family Services to study extending the age of foster care to age twenty-one.
