**Senate Bills on Second Reading to be Referred**

- SB 460 CARTER, T. FUNDS/FUNDING  
Repeals termination date of New Orleans Ferry Fund. (gov sig)
- SB 461 LONG ROADS/HIGHWAYS  
Designates a portion of Louisiana Highway 117 as the "Caroline Dorman Highway". (8/1/18)

**Senate Concurrent Resolutions 2nd Reading**

- SCR 13 CARTER, T. CONGRESS  
Memorializes Congress to pass the Disability Integration Act of 2017.
- SCR 14 WARD WATER/WATERWAYS  
Approves the Atchafalaya Basin Annual Plan for Fiscal Year 2018-2019, as adopted by the Atchafalaya Basin Research and Promotion Board and the Coastal Protection and Restoration Authority.
- SCR 16 COLOMB CONGRESS  
Memorializes Congress to address the deaf and hard of hearing provisions of the Americans with Disabilities Act.
- SCR 17 BISHOP, W. ROADS/HIGHWAYS  
Requests the New Orleans City Council to rename a portion of Higgins Boulevard as Johnny Jackson Jr. Boulevard to honor the memory of Johnny Jackson Jr., a former city councilman, state representative, and community leader.
- SCR 18 PEACOCK CONDOLENCES  
Expresses condolences upon the death of Emilie Michelle Gibson.

Relative to system membership. (6/30/18)

Corrects language regarding average final compensation. (6/30/18)

Provides for the classification of membership. (6/30/18)
- SB 9 PEACOCK STATE POLICE RET FUND  
Provides for determination of credits to be made to the experience account. (2/3 - CA10s29(F)) (6/30/18)
- SB 11 PEACOCK CLERKS OF COURT RET  
Provides for certain eligible rollover distributions. (6/30/18)
- SB 12 PEACOCK MUNICIPAL POL EMPS RET  
Provides for survivor benefits. (6/30/18)

- SB 341 DONAHUE FUNDS/FUNDING  
Provides for performance audits for statutory dedications that include a fee for service. (gov sig)
- SB 342 DONAHUE FISCAL CONTROLS  
Provides for modifications to the standstill budget to include means of finance substitutions for discretionary and nondiscretionary requirements. (8/1/18)
- SB 360 DONAHUE LOCAL FINANCE  
Reduces frequency of enhanced audits required of certain local auditees with at least three consecutive years of enhanced audits with no findings. (8/1/18)
- SB 390 CLAITOR SUITS AGAINST STATE  
Provides for the order of payment of judgments and compromises against the state, subject to funding. (gov sig)
