| SB | 360 | DONAHUE | LOCAL FINANCE | Reduces frequency of enhanced audits required of certain local auditees with at least three consecutive years of enhanced audits with no findings. (8/1/18) |
| SB | 390 | CLAITOR | SUITS AGAINST STATE | Provides for the order of payment of judgments and compromises against the state, subject to funding. (gov sig) |
