HOUSE BILLS ON FINAL PASSAGE - [13 items]

1. **HB180** **BAGLEY** **CRIME** Creates the crime of interfering with emergency communication
2. **HB183** **COX** **MINERALS/MINING** Levies an annual reclamation fee on surface mining operations
3. **HB184** **HENRY** **CRIME/ASSAULT** Prohibits harassment of a school or recreation athletic contest official
4. **HB202** **G.MILLER** **VOTERS/VOTING** Provides that a polling place for a precinct is not required to be opened under certain circumstances
5. **HB210** **J.HARRIS** **ENVIRONMENT/QUALITY DEPT** Provides for filing records of decisions of the Department of Environmental Quality
6. **HB241** **M.JOHNSON** **JUVENILES** Provides relative to certain crimes and delinquency provisions when the offender is under the age of eighteen
7. **HB271** **ANDERS** **INSURERS/ALIEN** Provides relative to the procedure following the merger or consolidation of foreign or alien insurers

11. **HB325** **S.BISHOP** **ELECTION CODE** Prohibits the registrar of voters, clerk of court, and Dept. of State from disclosing specified computer system information
12. **HB328** **JAY MORRIS** **ELECTIONS** Provides for restitution as part of the penalties for a person convicted of bribery of voters
13. **HB343** **S.CARTER** **LEGISLATION** Provides for technical corrections to various provisions of Title 17 of the La. Revised Statutes

2. **HB460** **TALBOT** **TAX CREDITS** Establishes an income and corporate franchise tax credit for purchase and installation of surveillance cameras in certain commercial vehicles

3. **HB494** **ABRAMSON** **TAX/SALES & USE** Provides relative to the determination of where sales and use taxes are due on purchases of certain raw materials converted into asphaltic concrete
4. **HB495** **ABRAMSON** **TAX/GAMING** Levies a state tax on the net gaming proceeds of fantasy sports contests, dedicates the avails of the tax, and authorizes a fee for issuance of certain licenses or permits

6. **HB507** **ABRAMSON** **TAX** Levies a 7% tax on the gross sales of therapeutic marijuana and dedicates the avails into the New Opportunities Waiver Fund
7. **HB127** **PIERRE** **TRANSPORTATION DEPT** Updates the classifications within the state highway system
8. **HB522** **ABRAMSON** **TAX/SALES-USE, LOCAL** Provides relative to the levy of sales and use taxes in the city of New Orleans
