- SB 8 RISER ROADS/HIGHWAYS
Designates LA 124 in Catahoula Parish as the "Lt. Col. R.V. McHale Memorial Highway". (gov sig)
- SB 9 PETERSON STATE EMPLOYEE RET
Removes future employees of the Regional Transit Authority from the system and state civil service. (6/30/19)
- SB 10 WHITE, BODI SHERIFFS PEN/RELIEF FUND
Provides relative to permanent benefit increases. (2/3 - CA10s29(F)) (6/30/2019)
- SB 16 LONG RETIREMENT BENEFITS
Provides relative to investment of lump-sum benefits. (6/30/19)
- SB 31 FANNIN ROADS/HIGHWAYS
Designates a portion of LA 34 in Jackson Parish as the "Second Lieutenant Harvel Moore Memorial Highway". (8/1/19)
- SB 44 JOHNS FUNDS/FUNDING
Authorizes the city of Lake Charles to bond certain state sales taxes dedicated to the Lake Charles Civic Center Fund. (gov sig)
- SB 47 ERDEY MOTOR CARRIERS
Requires the assistant secretary of OMV, not later than October 1, 2020, to establish, operate, and maintain commercial motor vehicle information systems and to deny or revoke commercial motor vehicle registration under certain circumstances. (8/1/19)
- SB 59 LONG TAX/INCOME/PERSONAL
Adds physician assistants to persons eligible for reduction to their individual income tax. (8/1/19)
