- SB 40 THOMPSON FUNDS/FUNDING
Repeals the Boll Weevil Eradication Fund and assessments on cotton producers and provides for the disposition of funds. (gov sig)
- SB 149 LUNEAU PUBLIC BUILDINGS/GROUNDS
Authorizes the state of Louisiana to sell or transfer certain state property. (8/1/19)
- SB 188 CHABERT LOCAL AGENCIES
Provides relative to the bonding authority of the Greater Lafourche Port Commission. (gov sig)
- SB 201 MIZELL LOCAL AGENCIES
Repeals the Washington Parish Reservoir District and authorizes the donation of any remaining property and excess funds to the Department of Culture, Recreation and Tourism in support of the Bogue Chitto State Park. (8/1/19)
- SB 224 BOUDREAUX TAX/INCOME/PERSONAL
Provides for the individual income tax credit for donations to school tuition organizations. (1/1/20)

- SB 23 PRICE CRIMINAL PROCEDURE
Provides relative to temporary detention of a person in custody pending a bail hearing. (8/1/19)
- SB 51 HEWITT HEALTH SERVICES
Provides relative to the qualifications for certified medication attendants. (8/1/19)
- SB 58 CARTER, T. VOTERS/VOTING
Provides for automatic voter registration by making an application for issuance or renewal of a driver's license or state identification card. (1/1/20)
- SB 64 SMITH, J. HEALTH/ACC INSURANCE
Authorizes group health insurance providers to consent on behalf of their employees for use of electronic documents. (8/1/19)
- SB 87 SMITH, J. INSURERS
Requires a nonresident producer to surrender the Louisiana nonresident license when the resident license on which it is based terminates. (1/1/2020)
- SB 108 SMITH, G. BONDS
Provides relative to criminal bail bonds. (8/1/19)
- SB 138 GATTI CRIME/PUNISHMENT
Provides relative to the definition of "serious bodily injury".
(gov sig)
- SB 146 MORRELL DOMESTIC VIOLENCE
Prohibits the incarceration of victims of domestic violence and sex offenses who refuse to testify against their abusers. (gov sig)
- SB 164 MORRISH HEALTH/ACC INSURANCE
Provides relative to the administration of prescription drug benefits. (8/1/19)
- SB 192 CHABERT LEGIS POWERS/FUNCTIONS
Provides relative to state symbols. (8/1/19)
- SB 199 SMITH, J. PUBLIC SFTY/CORRECT DEPT
Extends the insurance fraud investigation unit within the Department of Public Safety and Corrections and the insurance fraud prevention act. (7/1/19)
- SB 221 MIZELL ABORTION
Provides relative to abortion and the Woman's Right to Know law. (gov sig)
- SB 3 MIZELL MOTOR VEHICLES
Provides authority for the commissioner of the OMV to waive any penalty, procedure, or requirement for failure to maintain insurance provided that the principal driver of the motor vehicle is the registered owner or owner's spouse or child who was in the hospital or has died, and the owner can provide such proof to the commissioner. (gov sig)
