SB 66 RISER PUBLIC MEETINGS
Provides relative to open meetings of public bodies. (8/1/19)

Provides for a dental service care provider choosing the method by which such provider shall be reimbursed by an insurer. (8/1/19)

Provides relative to state banks and immovable property. (8/1/19)

SB 116 HENSGENS COMMERCIAL REGULATIONS
Provides for the transfer of certain going-out-of-business sale license deposits to the unclaimed property division of the Department of the Treasury. (7/1/19)

SB 126 PRICE CREDIT

Provides for automatic voter registration by making an application for issuance or renewal of a driver's
license or state identification card. (1/1/20)

Provides relative to the definition of "serious bodily injury".

Prohibits the incarceration of victims of domestic violence and sex offenses who refuse to testify against
