SB 159 DONAHUE LEGISLATIVE AUDITOR  
Provides for review and reports on cost recovery budget request forms completed by certain budget units. (gov sig)

SB 181 HEWITT FUNDS/FUNDING  
Provides relative to the classification, revision, dedication, or repeal of certain funds in the state treasury. (7/1/19)

SB 184 MILKOVICH ABORTION  
Prohibits the abortion of an unborn human being with a detectable heartbeat. (See Act)

SB 193 MORRISH OBLIGATIONS  
Enacts the Louisiana Structured Settlement Act. (gov sig)

SB 7 HENSGENS PHARMACEUTICALS  
Provides for the repeal of Medicaid prepaid coordinated care network pharmaceutical and therapeutics committees. (gov sig)
