SR 130 BISHOP, W. SPECIAL DAY/WEEK/MONTH  
Designates Wednesday, May 15, 2019, as New Orleans Day at the state capitol and commends the city of New Orleans.

**Senate Concurrent Resolutions 2nd Reading**

SCR 96 HEWITT BUDGET PROCEDURE  
Urges and requests the Revenue Estimating Conference to consider including all dedicated funds and fees and self-generated revenues in the projection of money available for appropriation in the long-range forecast.

Authorizes the governing authority of the city of New Orleans to levy a tax on short term rentals of overnight lodging

HB 196 FALCONER BOARDS/COMMISSIONS

HB 203 MILLER, G. PRIVILEGES/LIENS  
Provides relative to privileges on immovables

HB 223 BRASS MTR VEHICLE/TOWING  
Provides with respect to towing and storage licenses and fines

HB 245 HODGES PROCUREMENT  
Authorizes a public entity to reject the lowest bid on a procurement contract when a vendor engages in a boycott of Israel

HB 248 BROWN, CHAD CHILDREN/CUSTODY  
Provides for parenting coordinators in child custody proceedings

HB 299 CARMODY REAL ESTATE/REALTORS  
Provides relative to approval of certain continuing legal education courses by the Louisiana Real Estate Commission

HB 379 HARRIS, J. MTR VEHICLE/SEAT BELTS  
Provides with respect to applications of minors applying for driving privileges

Provides relative to purse distribution

Provides relative to the levy of sales and use taxes in the city of New Orleans

Requires a physical exam that meets or exceeds national standards for purposes of membership in the Firefighters' Retirement System

Provides relative to the Ernest N. Morial-New Orleans Exhibition Hall Authority

Constitutional amendment to abolish the death penalty. (2/3 - CA13s1(A))

SB 118 MILKOVICH CIVIL PROCEDURE  
Provides right of an oral argument in contradictory proceedings. (gov sig)

SB 136 MORRELL EMPLOYMENT  
Provides with respect to wage secrecy and pay discrimination. (8/1/19)

Provides relative to certain civil liability damages and prescription. (8/1/19)
