- HB 145 COUSSAN BANKS/BANKING
Provides for the disclosure of certain financial records to law enforcement pursuant to a search warrant
- HB 464 BERTHELOT AMUSEMENT PARKS
Provides relative to inflatable amusement devices, amusement attractions, and amusement rides
