HB 133 HOFFMANN ABORTION
Revises the definition of abortion

HB 205 HILFERTY LEVEES/BDS & DISTRICTS
Renames the Non-Flood Protection Asset Management Authority

HB 250 DAVIS HEALTH/BEHAVIORAL
Requires residential treatment facilities to provide access to medication-assisted treatment for patients with opioid use disorder

HB 277 LYONS ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE PERMT
Requires the commissioner of alcohol and tobacco control to suspend or revoke permits of certain alcoholic beverage dealers for failure to pay taxes

HB 425 JACKSON ABORTION
(Constitutional Amendment) Stipulates that no provision of the constitution protects a right to abortion or requires the funding of abortion
