Senate Resolutions 2nd Reading

- SR 19 BARROW HEALTH CARE
Urges the Louisiana Department of Health to recommend standards and curricula on the subject of implicit bias in the delivery of health care.
- SR 20 BARROW PUBLIC DEFENDER
Requests the study of the feasibility of establishing an optimal funding mechanism for the Louisiana Public Defender Board.

Senate Concurrent Resolutions 2nd Reading

- SCR 23 FOIL SPECIAL DAY/WEEK/MONTH
Declares April 2nd as World Autism Day in Louisiana, annually.

Senate Resolutions Reported by Committee to be Adopted

- SR 5 HENRY, CAMERON SENATE
Requires a roll call vote to adopt a resolution introduced on the last day of a legislative session.

Senate Concurrent Resolutions to be Adopted Subject to Call

- SCR 14 MILLS, ROBERT LIABILITY
Suspends certain provisions of law relative to safety belt evidence. (Item #40)
- SCR 15 MILLS, ROBERT LIABILITY INSURANCE
Suspends certain provisions of law relative to direct actions against insurers. (Item #40)
- SCR 16 MILLS, ROBERT COURTS
Suspends certain provisions of law relative to the jury trial threshold. (Item #40)

Senate Bills 3rd Reading and Final Passage

- SB 24 HARRIS, JIMMY TAX/TAXATION
Provides for eligibility for the Angel Investor Tax Credit for investments made in federal opportunity zones. (Item #19) (gov sig)
- SB 27 WHITE, B STATE AGENCIES
Creates and provides for the Streamlining Government Commission.
(Item #33) (gov sig)

Senate Bills 3rd Reading and Final Passage Subject to Call

- SB 20 WHITE, B FUNDS/FUNDING
Provides for the creation, transfer, dedication, deposit, and use of certain funds in the state treasury.
(Item #11) (gov sig)

House Concurrent Resolutions Reported by Committee to be adopted

- HCR 5 FREEMAN LEGISLATIVE AFFAIRS
Requests a study of the continuity of government provisions by the house and senate governmental affairs committees, meeting jointly
- HCR 6 WRIGHT U.S. CONSTITUTION
Calls for a convention to amend the United States Constitution to establish a limitation on terms for members of congress

House Bills 3rd Reading and Final Passage

- HB 4 MAGEE TAX CREDITS
Extends the date for eligible expenses to qualify for the tax credit for the rehabilitation of historic structures and extends the effectiveness of the credit (Item #19)
- HB 11 STEFANSKI TAX/SALES & USE
Provides for the amount of compensation persons required to collect state sales and use tax may deduct for remitting taxes (Item #30)
- HB 13 WRIGHT TAX CREDITS
Authorizes certain retail businesses to participate in the Enterprise Zone incentive (Item #18)

SB	395	CLOUD	ADVERTISING	Provides relative to false, misleading, or deceptive acts or practices and the award of certain costs and fees to the attorney general. (8/1/20)
SB	406	MIZELL	TELECOMMUNICATIONS	Provides for rural access to broadband high-speed internet service. (gov sig)
SB	418	TALBOT	LIABILITY INSURANCE	Enacts the Omnibus Premium Reduction Act of 2020. (1/1/21)
