- SR 35 CATHEY CONDOLENCES
Expresses condolences upon the death of Dr. Trapper Lee Munn.
- SR 36 CLOUD COMMENDATIONS
Commends Lance Corporal Kyle Miguel (K.M.) Savoy of the United States Marine Corps for being awarded an Outstanding Service medal in recognition of logistical work provided the 1st Marine Expeditionary Force.
- SR 37 JACKSON COMMENDATIONS

House Concurrent Resolutions Reported by Committee Subject to Call

HCR 6 WRIGHT U.S. CONSTITUTION
Calls for a convention to amend the United States Constitution to establish a limitation on terms for members of congress

House Concurrent Resolutions 3rd Reading and Final Passage

HCR 1 ZERINGUE FUNDS/FUNDING
Provides for monies in the Budget Stabilization Fund to be available for appropriation in Fiscal Year 2020-2021 (Item #14)

HCR 2 SCHEXNAYDER HOSPITALS
Provides for a hospital stabilization formula (Item #12)

House Bills 3rd Reading and Final Passage Subject to Call

HB 9 ZERINGUE FUNDS/FUNDING
Provides for the transfer, deposit, and use of monies among state funds (Item #10)

HB 11 STEFANSKI TAX/SALES & USE
Provides for the amount of compensation persons required to collect state sales and use tax may deduct for remitting taxes (Item #30)

HB 13 WRIGHT TAX CREDITS
Authorizes certain retail businesses to participate in the Enterprise Zone incentive (Item #18)

HB 19 PRESSLY TAX/TAX REBATES
Extends eligibility requirements for certain industries to participate in the Quality Jobs Program (Item #18)

HB 4 MAGEE TAX CREDITS
Extends the date for eligible expenses to qualify for the tax credit for the rehabilitation of historic structures and extends the effectiveness of the credit (Item #19)

HB 6 IVEY FUNDS/FUNDING
Establishes the State Cybersecurity and Information Technology Fund and dedicates revenues to the fund (Items #10 and #11)

HB 57 SCHEXNAYDER CIVIL/ACTIONS
Enacts the Civil Justice Reform Act of 2020 (Item #40)

Reconsideration of Vetoed Bills

SB 132 HENRY, CAMERON CONTRACTS
Provides for reporting to and approval of all state contracts valued at twenty-five million dollars or more annually by the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget. (7/1/20)

SB 395 CLOUD ADVERTISING
Provides relative to false, misleading, or deceptive acts or practices and the award of certain costs and fees to the attorney general. (8/1/20)

SB 406 MIZELL TELECOMMUNICATIONS
Provides for rural access to broadband high-speed internet service. (gov sig)

SB 418 TALBOT LIABILITY INSURANCE
Enacts the Omnibus Premium Reduction Act of 2020. (1/1/21)
